Men … Unrighteous … Utters Oaths And Deceptions - His tongue utters oaths and deceptions and oppression, his mouth is full of trouble and what is hurtful (Psalms 10:7) [14] - References

Psalms 10:7" His mouth is full of oaths and of deceptions and of oppression. Under his tongue are trouble and what is hurtful.

[14] - References

- You will destroy those speaking a lie. A man of bloodshed and deception Yehowah detests. (Psalms 5:6)
- For the sin of their mouth, the word of their lips, and may they be caught in their pride, even for the cursing and the deception that they rehearse. (Psalms 59:12)
- And their mouth is full of cursing and bitter expression. (Romans 3:14)
- For, he that would love life and see good days, let him restrain his tongue from what is bad and his lips from speaking deception. (1 Peter 3:10)
- Look! There is one that is pregnant with what is hurtful, and he has conceived trouble and is bound to give birth to falsehood. (Psalms 7:14)
- Untruth they keep speaking one to the other, with a smooth lip they keep speaking even with a double heart. (Psalms 12:2)
- Smoother than butter are the words of his mouth, but his heart is disposed to fight. His words are softer than oil, but they are drawn swords. (Psalms 55:21)
- The mouth of the righteous one, it bears the fruit of wisdom, but the tongue of perverseness will be cut off. (Proverbs 10:31)
- The evildoer is paying attention to the lip of hurtfulness. A falsifier is giving ear to the tongue causing adversities. (Proverbs 17:4)

- For the wicked themselves will perish, and the enemies of Yehowah will be like the preciousness of pastures, they must come to their end. In smoke they must come to their end. (Psalms 37:20)
- Whose mouth has spoken what is untrue and whose right hand is a right hand of falsehood. (Psalms 144:8)
- A good-for-nothing man, a man of hurtfulness, is walking with crookedness of speech. (Proverbs 6:12)
- As for the unprincipled man, his instruments are bad, he himself has given counsel for acts of loose conduct, to wreck the afflicted ones with false sayings, even when someone poor speaks what is right. (Isaiah 32:7)
