Men ··· Unrighteous ··· View Themselves As Righteous - There is a generation viewing itself as righteous, but which is covered in excrement in Yehowah's eyes · (Proverbs 30:12) [14] - References

Proverbs 30:12... There is a generation that is pure in its own eyes but that has not been washed from its own excrement.

[14] - References

- For he has acted too smoothly to himself in his own eyes to find out his error so as to hate it. (Psalms 36:2)
- Those who are saying; Keep close to yourself. Do not approach me, for I shall certainly convey holiness to you. These are a smoke in my nostrils, a fire burning all day long. (Isaiah 65:5)
- Consequently he said to them; You are those who declare yourselves righteous before men, but God knows your hearts, because what is lofty among men is a disgusting thing in God's sight. (Luke 16:15)
- Betrayers, headstrong, puffed up with pride, lovers of pleasures rather than lovers of God. (2 Timothy 3:4)
- If we make the statement; We have no sin, we are misleading ourselves and the truth is not in us. (1 John 1:8)
- Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! Because you resemble whitewashed graves, which outwardly indeed appear beautiful but inside are full of dead men's bones and of every sort of uncleanness. (Matthew 23:27)
- But the Lord said to him; Now you Pharisees, you cleanse the outside of the cup and dish, but the inside of you is full of plunder and wickedness. (Luke 11:39)
- There exists a way that is upright before a man, but the ways of death are the end of it afterward. (Proverbs 14:12)
- All the ways of a man are pure in his own eyes, but Yehowah is making an estimate of spirits. (Proverbs 16:2)

- Every way of a man is upright in his own eyes, but Yehowah is making an estimate of hearts. (Proverbs 21:2)
- And Ephraim keeps saying; Indeed, I have become rich, I have found valuable things for myself. As regards all my toiling, they will find, on my part, no error that is sin. (Hosea 12:8)
- You people have made Yehowah weary by Your words, and You have said; In what way have we made him weary? By Your saying; Everyone that is doing bad is good in the eyes of Yehowah, and in such ones he himself has taken delight, or, Where is the God of justice? (Malachi 2:17)
- I tell you that thus there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner that repents than over ninety-nine righteous ones who have no need of repentance. (Luke 15:7)
