- For he **has** acted too smoothly to himself in his **own eyes** to find out his error so as to hate it. (**Psalms 36:2**)
- Those who are saying; Keep close to yourself. Do not approach me, for I shall certainly convey holiness to you. These are a smoke in my nostrils, a fire burning all day long. (**Isaiah 65:5**)
- Consequently he said to them; **You** are those who declare yourselves righteous before men, but God knows **YOUR** hearts, because what is lofty among men is a disgusting thing in God's sight. (**Luke 16:15**)
- Betrayers, headstrong, puffed up with pride, lovers of pleasures rather than lovers of God. (**2 Timothy 3:4**)
- If we make the statement; We have no sin, we are misleading ourselves and the truth is not in us. (**1 John 1:8**)
- Woe to **you**, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! Because **you** resemble whitewashed graves, which outwardly indeed appear beautiful but inside are full of dead men's bones and of every sort of uncleanness. (**Matthew 23:27**)
- But the Lord said to him; Now **you** Pharisees, **you** cleanse the outside of the cup and dish, but the inside of **you** is full of plunder and wickedness. (**Luke 11:39**)
- There exists a way that is upright before a man, but the ways of death are the end of it afterward. (**Proverbs 14:12**)
- All the ways of a man are **pure** in his **own eyes**, but Yehowah is making an estimate of spirits. (**Proverbs 16:2**)

- Every way of a man is upright in his **own eyes**, but Yehowah is making an estimate of hearts. (**Proverbs 21:2**)
- And Ephraim keeps saying; Indeed, I have become rich, I have found valuable things for myself. As regards all my toiling, they will find, on my part, no error that is sin. (**Hosea 12:8**)
- **You** people have made Yehowah weary by **YOUR** words, and **YOU** have said; In what way have we made him weary? By **YOUR** saying; Everyone that is doing bad is good in the **eyes** of Yehowah, and in such ones he himself **has** taken delight, or, Where is the God of justice? (**Malachi 2:17**)
- I tell **you** that thus there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner that repents than over ninety-nine righteous ones who have no need of repentance. (**Luke 15:7**)
- But he spoke this illustration also to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous and who considered the rest as nothing. (**Luke 18:9**)
