## Proverbs 21:2" Every way of a man is upright in his own eyes, but Yehowah is making an estimate of hearts.

- For he has acted too smoothly to himself in his own eyes to find out his error so as to hate it. (Psalms 36:2)
- All the ways of a man are pure in his own eyes, but Yehowah is making an estimate of spirits. (Proverbs 16:2)
- There is a generation that is pure in its own eyes, but that has not been washed from its own excrement. (Proverbs 30:12)
