Men ··· Unrighteous ··· Who Spoke In Disbelief - Is this not the carpenter's son, Do we not know his mother and his brothers (Matthew 13:55) [18] - References

Matthew 13:55. Is this not the carpenter's son? Is not his mother called Mary, and his brothers James and Joseph and Simon and Judas?

[18] - References

- This is the carpenter the son of Mary and the brother of James and Joseph and Judas and Simon, is it not? And his sisters are here with us, are they not? So they began to stumble at him. (Mark 6:3)
- Furthermore, Jesus himself, when he commenced his work, was about thirty years old, being the son, as the opinion was, of Joseph, son of Heli. (Luke 3:23)
- And they all began to give favorable witness about him and to marvel at the winsome words proceeding out of his mouth, and they were saying; This is a son of Joseph, is it not? (Luke 4:22)
- And they began saying; Is this not Jesus the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? How is it that now he says, I have come down from heaven? (John 6:42)
- Jacob became father to Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom Jesus was born, who is called Christ. (Matthew 1:16)
- While he was yet speaking to the crowds, look! His mother and brothers took up a position outside seeking to speak to him. (Matthew 12:46)
- Now his mother and his brothers came, and, as they were standing on the outside, they sent in to him to call him. (Mark 3:31)
- Now his mother and brothers came toward him, but they were unable to get to him because of the crowd. (Luke 8:19)
- Philip found Nathanael and said to him; We have found the one of whom Moses, in the Law, and the Prophets wrote, Jesus, the son of Joseph, from Nazareth. (John 1:45)

- After this he and his mother and brothers and his disciples went down to Capernaum, but they did not stay there many days. (John 2:12)
- His brothers were, in fact, not exercising faith in him. (John 7:5)
- On the contrary, we know where this man is from, yet when the Christ comes, no one is to know where he is from. (John 7:27)
- With one accord all these were persisting in prayer, together with some women and Mary the mother of Jesus and with his brothers. (Acts of Apostles 1:14)
- But he motioned to them with his hand to be silent and told them in detail how Yehowah brought him out of the prison, and he said; Report these things to James and the brothers. With that he went out and journeyed to another place. (Acts of Apostles 12:17)
- We have authority to lead about a sister as a wife, even as the rest of the apostles and the Lord's brothers and Cephas, do we not? (1 Corinthians 9:5)
- But I saw no one else of the apostles, only James the brother of the Lord. (Galatians 1:19)
- James, a slave of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes that are scattered about; Greetings! (James 1:1)
- Jude, a slave of Jesus Christ, but a brother of James, to the called ones who are loved in relationship with God the Father and preserved for Jesus Christ. (Jude 1:1)
