## **WICKED - WILL NOT TAKE DISCIPLINE TO HEART**

Men "Unrighteous "Will Not Take Discipline To Heart - He kept pouring out his rage and anger and strength of war against them and consuming them all around but they took no note and would lay nothing to heart" (Isaiah 42:25) [22] - References

Isaiah 42:25... So He kept pouring out upon him rage, his anger, and the strength of war. And it kept consuming him all around, but he took no note, and it kept blazing up against him, but he would lay nothing to heart.

[22] - References

- For a fire has been ignited in my anger and it will burn down to Sheol, the lowest place, and it will consume the earth and its produce and will set ablaze the foundations of mountains. (Deuteronomy 32:22)
- I shall increase calamities upon them, My arrows I shall spend upon them. (Deuteronomy 32:23)
- Exhausted from hunger they will be and eaten up by burning fever and bitter destruction. And the teeth of beasts I shall send upon them, with the venom of reptiles of the dust. (Deuteronomy 32:24)
- Outdoors a sword will bereave them, and indoors fright, of both young man and virgin, suckling together with gray-haired man. (Deuteronomy 32:25)
- For they are a nation on whom counsel perishes, and among them there is no understanding. (Deuteronomy 32:28)
- In the face of his denunciation who can stand? And who can rise up against the heat of his anger? His own rage will certainly be poured out like fire, and the very rocks will actually be pulled down because of him. (Nahum 1:6)
- In those days Yehowah started to cut off Israel piece by piece, and Hazael kept striking them in all the territory of Israel. (2 Kings 10:32)

- And he proceeded to burn the house of Yehowah and the king's house and all the houses of Jerusalem, and the house of every great man he burned with fire. (2 Kings 25:9)
- And the people themselves have not returned to the One striking them, and Yehowah of armies they have not sought. (Isaiah 9:13)
- And Yehowah will cut off from Israel head and tail, shoot and rush, in one day. (Isaiah 9:14)
- The aged and highly respected one is the head, and the prophet giving false instruction is the tail. (Isaiah 9:15)
- And those who are leading this people on prove to be the ones causing them to wander, and those of them who are being led on, the ones who are being confused. (Isaiah 9:16)
- O Yehowah, are not those eyes of yours toward faithfulness? You have struck them, but they did not become ill. You exterminated them. They refused to take discipline. They made their faces harder than a crag. They refused to turn back. (Jeremiah 5:3)
- Even I myself had said; Surely they are of low class. They acted foolishly, for they have ignored the way of Yehowah, the judgment of their God. (Jeremiah 5:4)
- I will go my way to the great ones and speak with them, for they themselves must have taken note of the way of Yehowah, the judgment of their God. Surely they themselves must have all together broken the yoke, they must have torn apart the bands. (Jeremiah 5:5)
- Strangers have eaten up his power, and he himself has not come to know it. Also, gray hairs themselves have become white on him, but he himself has not come to know it. (Hosea 7:9)
- And the pride of Israel has testified to his face, and they have not returned to Yehowah their God, nor have they looked for him because of all this. (Hosea 7:10)
- Whom did you become frightened at and begin to fear, so that you took up lying? But I was not the one that you remembered. You took nothing to your heart. Was I not keeping silent and hiding matters? So you were in no fear even of me. (Isaiah 57:11)
- I myself shall tell forth your righteousness and your works, that they will not benefit you. (Isaiah 57:12)

- When you cry for aid your collection of things will not deliver you, but a wind will carry even all of them away. An exhalation will take them away, but the one taking refuge in me will inherit the land and will take possession of my holy mountain. (Isaiah 57:13)
- If you will not listen, and if you will not lay it to heart to give glory to my name, Yehowah of armies has said, I shall also certainly send upon you the curse, and I will curse your blessings. Yes, I have even cursed the blessing, because you are not laying it to heart. (Malachi 2:2)
- He went sending upon them his burning anger, fury and denunciation and distress, deputations of angels bringing calamity. (Psalms 78:49)
- I grew indignant at my people. I profaned my inheritance, and I proceeded to give them into your hand. You showed them no mercies. Upon the old man you made your yoke very heavy. (Isaiah 47:6)
- Whom did you become frightened at and begin to fear, so that you took up lying? But I was not the one that you remembered. You took nothing to your heart. Was I not keeping silent and hiding matters? So you were in no fear even of me. (Isaiah 57:11)
- O Yehowah, are not those eyes of yours toward faithfulness? You have struck them, but they did not become ill. You exterminated them. They refused to take discipline. They made their faces harder than a crag. They refused to turn back. (Jeremiah 5:3)
- One has made it a desolate waste, it has withered away, it is desolated to me. The whole land has been made desolate, because there is no man that has taken it to heart. (Jeremiah 12:11)
- And I will cause them to pass over with your enemies into a land that you have not known. For a fire itself has been ignited in my anger. Against you people it is kindled. (Jeremiah 15:14)
- In the heat of anger he has cut down every horn of Israel. He has turned his right hand back from before the enemy, and in Jacob he keeps burning like a flaming fire that has devoured all around. (Lamentations 2:3)
- He has trodden his bow like an enemy. His right hand has taken its position like an adversary, and he kept killing all those desirable to the eyes. Into the tent of the daughter of Zion he has poured out his rage, just like fire. (Lamentations 2:4)

And I proceeded to pour out my rage upon them on account of the blood that they had poured out upon the land, which land they had made unclean with their dungy idols. (Ezekiel 36:18)
