**Malachi 3:10** • **Bring all the tenth parts into the storehouse, that there may come to be food in my house, and test me out, please, in this respect, Yehowah of armies has said, whether I shall not open to you people the floodgates of the heavens and actually empty out upon you a blessing until there is no more want.**

- And every **tenth** part of the land, **out** of the seed of the land and the fruit of the tree, belongs to **Yehowah**. It is something holy to **Yehowah**. **(Leviticus 27:30)**
- At the end of three years you will bring **out** the entire **tenth** part of your produce in that year, and you must deposit it inside your gates. **(Deuteronomy 14:28)**
- At this Hezekiah **said** to prepare dining rooms in the **house** of **Yehowah**. Accordingly they prepared them. **(2 Chronicles 31:11)**
- Further, there were appointed on that day men over the halls for the stores, for the contributions, for the firstfruits and for the **tenths**, to gather into them **out** of the fields of the cities the portions called for by the Law for the priests and the Levites, for the rejoicing of Judah was because of the priests and of the Levites who were in attendance. **(Nehemiah 12:44)**
- And I got to find **out** that the very portions of the Levites had not been given them, so that the Levites and the singers doing the work went running off, each one to his own field. **(Nehemiah 13:10)**
- God, moreover, is able to make all his undeserved kindness abound toward **you**, that, while **you** always have full self-sufficiency in everything, **you** may have plenty for every good work. **(2 Corinthians 9:8)**

- **Yehowah** will **open** up to you his good **storehouse**, the **heavens**, to give the rain on your land in its season and to bless every deed of your hand, and you will certainly lend to many nations, while you yourself will not borrow. (**Deuteronomy 28:12**)
- But the adjutant answered the man of the true God and **said**; Even if **Yehowah** were making **floodgates** in the **heavens**, could it take place according to this word? To this he **said**; Here you are seeing it with your own eyes, but from it you will not eat. (**2 Kings 7:19**)
- And **you** will certainly eat the old of the preceding year, and **you** will bring **out** the old ahead of the new. (**Leviticus 26:10**)
- Then Azariah the chief priest of the **house** of Zadok **said** to him, yes, he **said**; From the time they started to bring the contribution into the **house** of **Yehowah** there **has** been an eating and getting satisfied and having a surplus in abundance, for **Yehowah** himself **has** blessed his **people**, and what **has** been left over is this great plenty. (**2 Chronicles 31:10**)
- Then your stores of supply will be filled with plenty, and with new wine your own press vats will overflow. (**Proverbs 3:10**)
- The **blessing** of **Yehowah**, that is what makes rich, and he adds no pain with it. (**Proverbs 10:22**)
- And Joseph continued piling up grain in very great quantity, like the sand of the sea, **until** finally they gave up counting it, because it was without number. (**Genesis 41:49**)
- He is from the God of your father, and he will help you, and he is with the Almighty, and he will bless you with the **blessings** of the **heavens** above, with the **blessings** of the watery deep lying down below, with the **blessings** of the breasts and womb. (**Genesis 49:25**)
- And **you** must serve **Yehowah** **YOUR** God, and he will certainly bless your bread and your water, and I shall indeed turn malady away from your midst. (**Exodus 23:25**)
- In that case I shall certainly command my **blessing** for **you** in the sixth year, and it must yield its crop for three years. (**Leviticus 25:21**)
- Now in case the journey should be too long for you, because you will not be able to carry it, since the place that **Yehowah** your God will choose to place his name there will be too far away for you, because **Yehowah** your God will bless you. (**Deuteronomy 14:24**)

- And the Levite, because he **has** no share or inheritance with you, and the alien resident and the fatherless boy and the widow, who are inside your gates, must **come**, and they must eat and satisfy themselves, in order, that **Yehowah** your God may bless you in every deed of your hand that you will do. (**Deuteronomy 14:29**)
- **Yehowah** will decree for you the **blessing** on your stores of supply and every undertaking of yours, and he will certainly bless you in the land that **Yehowah** your God is giving you. (**Deuteronomy 28:8**)
- And **Yehowah** your God will indeed make you have more than enough in every work of your hand, in the fruit of your belly and the fruit of your domestic animals and the fruitage of your soil, resulting in prosperity, because **Yehowah** will again exult over you for good, just as he exulted over your forefathers. (**Deuteronomy 30:9**)
- And the ark of **Yehowah** kept dwelling at the **house** of Obed-edom the Gittite three months, and **Yehowah** kept **blessing** Obed-edom and all his household. (**2 Samuel 6:11**)
- At that the adjutant upon whose hand the king was supporting himself answered the man of the true God and **said**; If **Yehowah** were making **floodgates** in the **heavens**, could this thing take place? To this he **said**; Here you are seeing it with your own eyes, but from it you will not eat. (**2 Kings 7:2**)
- And the ark of the true God kept dwelling with the household of Obed-edom, at his **house** three months, and **Yehowah** kept **blessing** the household of Obed-edom and all that was his. (**1 Chronicles 13:14**)
- So he **said** to Judah; Let us build these cities and make walls around and towers, double doors and bars. For us the land is yet available, because we have searched for **Yehowah** our God. We have searched, and he gives us rest all around. And they went building and proving successful. (**2 Chronicles 14:7**)
- And all Judah, for their part, brought in the **tenth** of the grain and of the new wine and of the oil to the stores. (**Nehemiah 13:12**)
- He will carry away **blessing** from **Yehowah** and righteousness from his God of salvation. (**Psalms 24:5**)
- You have crowned the year with your goodness, and your very tracks drip with fatness. (**Psalms 65:11**)
- And he proceeded to command the cloudy skies above, and he opened the very doors of heaven. (**Psalms 78:23**)

- To cause those loving me to take possession of substance, and their **storehouses** I keep filled. (**Proverbs 8:21**)
- Blessings are for the head of the righteous one, but as regards the mouth of the wicked ones, it covers up violence. (**Proverbs 10:6**)
- And in your case the opposite thing takes place from that of other women in your acts of prostitution, and after your style no prostitution **has** been committed, even in your giving hire when no hire **has** been given to you, and so it occurs in the opposite way. (**Ezekiel 16:34**)
- And I will make them and the surroundings of my hill a **blessing**, and I will cause the pouring rain to descend in its time. Pouring rains of **blessing** there will prove to be. (**Ezekiel 34:26**)
- And the stone wall that was outside was close by the dining rooms toward the outer courtyard before the other dining rooms. Its length was fifty cubits. (**Ezekiel 42:7**)
- And the first of all the first ripe fruits of everything and every contribution of everything **out** of all **YOUR** contributions, to the priests it will **come** to belong, and the firstfruits of **YOUR** coarse meals **YOU** should give to the priest, in order to cause a **blessing** to rest upon your **house**. (**Ezekiel 44:30**)
- And **Yehowah** will answer and say to his **people**, Here I am sending to **you** the grain and the new wine and the oil, and **you people** will certainly be satisfied with it, and I shall not make **you** anymore a reproach among the nations. (**Joel 2:19**)
- And the threshing floors must be full of cleansed grain, and the press vats must overflow with new wine and oil. (**Joel 2:24**)
