Men … All Men … Wicked And Righteous, Distinction - You people will certainly see the distinction between a righteous one and a wicked one between those serving Yehowah and one who has not served him. (Malachi 3:18) [18] - References

Malachi 3:18... And you people will again certainly see the distinction between a righteous one and a wicked one, between one serving God and one who has not served him.

- And mankind will say; Surely there is fruitage for the righteous one. Surely there exists a God that is judging in the earth. (Psalms 58:11)
- And he will render to each one according to his works. (Romans 2:6)
- And the ones having insight will shine like the brightness of the expanse, and those who are bringing the many to righteousness, like the stars to time indefinite, even forever. (Daniel 12:3)
- At that time the righteous ones will shine as brightly as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Let him that has ears listen. (Matthew 13:43)
- After that Yehowah said to Noah; Go, you and all your household, into the ark, because you are the one I have seen to be righteous before me among this generation. (Genesis 7:1)
- It is unthinkable of you that you are acting in this manner to put to death the righteous man with the wicked one so that it has to occur with the righteous man as it does with the wicked! It is unthinkable of you. Is the Judge of all the earth not going to do what is right? (Genesis 18:25)
- And I shall indeed set a demarcation between my people and your people. Tomorrow this sign will take place. (Exodus 8:23)

- And Yehowah will certainly make a distinction between the livestock of Israel and the livestock of Egypt, and not a thing of all that belongs to the sons of Israel will die. (Exodus 9:4)
- They did not see one another, and none of them got up from his own place three days, but for all the sons of Israel there proved to be light in their dwellings. (Exodus 10:23)
- But against any of the sons of Israel will no dog move eagerly its tongue, from man to beast, in order, that you people may know that Yehowah can make a distinction between the Egyptians and the sons of Israel. (Exodus 11:7)
- That is why the wicked ones will not stand up in the judgment, nor sinners in the assembly of righteous ones. (Psalms 1:5)
- And he will certainly bring forth your righteousness as the light itself, and your justice as the midday. (Psalms 37:6)
- Only with your eyes will you look on and see the retribution itself of the wicked ones. (Psalms 91:8)
- The way of the lazy one is like a brier hedge, but the path of the upright ones is a way cast up. (Proverbs 15:19)
- The senseless one will no longer be called generous, and as for the unprincipled man, he will not be said to be noble. (Isaiah 32:5)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Look! My own servants will eat, but you yourselves will go hungry. Look! My own servants will drink, but you yourselves will go thirsty. Look! My own servants will rejoice, but you yourselves will suffer shame. (Isaiah 65:13)
- And you will certainly see, and your heart will be bound to exult, and your very bones will sprout just like tender grass. And the hand of Yehowah will certainly be made known to his servants, but he will actually denounce his enemies. (Isaiah 66:14)
- Even for them to ask for mercies on the part of the God of heaven concerning this secret, in order, that they might not destroy Daniel and his companions with the remainder of the wise men of Babylon. (Daniel 2:18)
