1 Peter 4:3 For the time that has passed by is sufficient for **YOU** to have worked out the will of the nations when **YOU** proceeded in deeds of loose conduct, lusts, excesses with wine, revelries, drinking matches, and illegal idolatries.

- True, God has overlooked the times of such ignorance, yet now he is telling mankind that they should all everywhere repent. (**Acts of Apostles 17:30**)
- And just as they did not approve of holding God in accurate knowledge, God gave them up to a disapproved mental state, to do the things not fitting. (**Romans 1:28**)
- What, then, was the fruit that **YOU** used to **have** at that time? Things of which **YOU** are now ashamed. For the end of those things is death. (**Romans 6:21**)
- This, therefore, I say and bear witness to in the Lord, that **YOU** no longer go on walking just as the **nations** also walk in the unprofitableness of their minds. (**Ephesians 4:17**)
- For even we were once senseless, disobedient, being misled, being slaves to various desires and pleasures, carrying on in badness and envy, abhorrent, hating one another. (**Titus 3:3**)
- Having come to be past all moral sense, they gave themselves over to **loose conduct** to work uncleanness of every sort with greediness. (**Ephesians 4:19**)
- For they utter swelling expressions of no profit, and by the desires of the flesh and by **loose** habits they entice those who are just escaping from people who **conduct** themselves in error. (**2 Peter 2:18**)

- My reason is that certain men **have** slipped in who **have** long ago been appointed by the Scriptures to this judgment, ungodly men, turning the undeserved kindness of our God into an excuse for **loose conduct** and proving false to our only Owner and Lord, Jesus Christ. (**Jude 1:4**)
- But now I am writing **you** to quit mixing in company with anyone called a brother that is a fornicator or a greedy person or an idolater or a reviler or a drunkard or an extortioner, not even eating with such a man. (**1 Corinthians 5:11**)
- Envies, drunken bouts, **revelries**, and things like these. As to these things I am forewarning **you**, the same way as I did forewarn **you**, that those who practice such things **will** not inherit God's kingdom. (**Galatians 5:21**)
- As in the daytime let us walk decently, not in **revelries** and drunken bouts, not in illicit intercourse and **loose conduct**, not in strife and jealousy. (**Romans 13:13**)
- Do not profane your daughter by making her a prostitute, in order, that the land may not commit prostitution and the land actually be filled with **loose** morals. (**Leviticus 19:29**)
- Hence I grasped my concubine and cut her up and sent her into every field of Israel's inheritance, because they had carried on **loose conduct** and disgraceful folly in Israel. (**Judges 20:6**)
- Do not come to be among heavy drinkers of **wine**, among those who are gluttonous eaters of flesh. (**Proverbs 23:20**)
- Better is it to go to the house of mourning than to go to the banquet house, because that is the end of all mankind, and the one alive should take it to his heart. (**Ecclesiastes 7:2**)
- Your **loose conduct** and your detestable things, you yourself must bear them, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 16:58**)
- And you must say to Rebelliousness, to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; That is enough of **you** because of all **your** detestable things, O house of Israel. (**Ezekiel 44:6**)
- I **will** rise and journey to my father and say to him; Father, I **have** sinned against heaven and against you. (**Luke 15:18**)
- For he that practices vile things hates the light and does not come to the light, in order, that his works may not be reproved. (**John 3:20**)

- Repent, therefore, and turn around so as to get **YOUR** sins blotted **out**, that seasons of refreshing may come from the person of Yehowah (**Acts of Apostles 3:19**)
- To keep abstaining from things sacrificed to idols and from blood and from things strangled and from fornication. If **you** carefully keep yourselves from these things, **you will** prosper. Good health to **you!** (**Acts of Apostles 15:29**)
- As for the believers from among the **nations**, we **have** sent **out**, rendering our decision that they should keep themselves from what is sacrificed to idols as well as from blood and what is strangled and from fornication. (**Acts of Apostles 21:25**)
- Filled as they were with all unrighteousness, wickedness, covetousness, badness, being full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malicious disposition, being whisperers. (**Romans 1:29**)
- For **you** are yet fleshly. For whereas there are jealousy and strife among **you**, are **you** not fleshly and are **you** not walking as men do? (**1 Corinthians 3:3**)
- Consequently let us keep the festival, not with old leaven, neither with leaven of badness and wickedness, but with unfermented cakes of sincerity and truth. (**1 Corinthians 5:8**)
- Nor thieves, nor greedy persons, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners **will** inherit God's kingdom. (**1 Corinthians 6:10**)
- **You** know that when **you** were people of the **nations**, **you** were being led away to those voiceless idols just as **you** happened to be led. (**1 Corinthians 12:2**)
- Yes, among them we all at one time conducted ourselves in harmony with the desires of our flesh, doing the things willed by the flesh and the thoughts, and we were naturally children of wrath even as the rest. (**Ephesians 2:3**)
- Not in covetous sexual appetite such as also those **nations have** which do not know God. (**1 Thessalonians 4:5**)
