Psalms 34:15... The eyes of Yehowah are toward the righteous ones, and his ears are toward their cry for help.

[28] - References

- He will not take away his eyes from anyone righteous, even kings on the throne he will also seat them forever, and they will be exalted. (Job 36:7)
- Look! The eye of Yehowah is toward those fearing him, to those waiting for his loving-kindness. (Psalms 33:18)
- For the eyes of Yehowah are upon the righteous ones, and his ears are toward their supplication, but the face of Yehowah is against those doing bad things. (1 Peter 3:12)
- The desire of the meek ones you will certainly hear, O Yehowah. You will prepare their heart. You will pay attention with your ear. (Psalms 10:17)
- In my distress I kept calling upon Yehowah, and to my God I kept crying for help. Out of his temple he proceeded to hear my voice, and my own cry before him for help now came into his ears. (Psalms 18:6)
- The One planting the ear, can he not hear? Or the One forming the eye, can he not look? (Psalms 94:9)
- Look! The hand of Yehowah has not become too short that it cannot save, nor has his ear become too heavy that it cannot hear. (Isaiah 59:1)
- So he said to him; Here I do show you consideration to this extent also, by my not overthrowing the city of which you have spoken. (Genesis 19:21)
- Well, it came about that before he had finished speaking, why, here coming out was Rebekah, who had been born to Bethuel the son

of Milcah the wife of Nahor, Abraham's brother, and her water jar was upon her shoulder. (Genesis 24:15)

- And she became pregnant again and brought a son to birth and then said; It is because Yehowah has listened, in that I was hated and so he gave me also this one. Hence she called his name Simeon. (Genesis 29:33)
- A land that Yehowah your God is caring for. The eyes of Yehowah your God are constantly upon it, from the beginning of the year to the close of the year. (Deuteronomy 11:12)

- Now, O my God, please, let your eyes prove to be opened and your ears attentive to the prayer respecting this place. (2 Chronicles 6:40)
- And the eye of their God proved to be upon the older men of the Jews, and they did not stop them until the report could go to Darius and then an official document concerning this could be sent back. (Ezra 5:5)
- Go, gather all the Jews that are to be found in Shushan and fast in my behalf and neither eat nor drink for three days, night and day. I too with my young women, I shall fast likewise, and upon that I shall come in to the king, which is not according to the Law, and in case I must perish, I must perish. (Esther 4:16)
- So take knowledge that Yehowah will certainly distinguish his loval one, Yehowah himself will hear when I call to him. (Psalms 4:3)
- I earnestly hoped in Yehowah, and so he inclined his ear to me and heard my cry for help. (Psalms 40:1)
- As for me, because of my integrity you have upheld me, and you will set me before your face to time indefinite. (Psalms 41:12)
- In your righteousness may you deliver me and provide me with escape. Incline to me your ear and save me. (Psalms 71:2)

- My eyes are upon the faithful ones of the earth, that they may dwell with me. The one walking in a faultless way, he it is who will minister to me. (Psalms 101:6)
- For he has inclined his ear to me, and throughout my days I shall call. (Psalms 116:2)
- O Yehowah, do hear my voice. May your ears prove to be attentive to the voice of my entreaties. (Psalms 130:2)
- Yehowah is far away from the wicked ones, but the prayer of the righteous ones he hears. (Proverbs 15:29)
- In that case you would call, and Yehowah himself would answer, you would cry for help, and he would say; Here I am! If you will remove from your midst the yoke bar, the poking out of the finger and the speaking of what is hurtful. (Isaiah 58:9)
