WISDOM - ACQUIRE IT AS THE PRIME THING IN LIFE

Men ··· Righteous ··· Wisdom - Acquire wisdom as the prime thing, with all things acquire understanding (Proverbs 4:7) [15] -References

Proverbs 4:7" Wisdom is the prime thing. Acquire wisdom, and with all that you acquire, acquire understanding.

[15] - References

- The fear of Yehowah is the start of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Most Holy One is what understanding is. (Proverbs 9:10)
- For wisdom is for a protection the same as money is for a protection, but the advantage of knowledge is that wisdom itself preserves alive its owners. (Ecclesiastes 7:12)
- Who is there like the wise one? And who is there knowing the interpretation of a thing? The wisdom of a man itself causes his face to shine, and even the sternness of his face is changed for the better. (Ecclesiastes 8:1)
- Carefully concealed in him are all the treasures of wisdom and of knowledge. (Colossians 2:3)
- I have counsel and practical wisdom. I, understanding, I have mightiness. (Proverbs 8:14)
- The understanding heart is one that searches for knowledge, but the mouth of stupid people is one that aspires to foolishness. (Proverbs 15:14)
- As for the one sown upon the fine soil, this is the one hearing the word and getting the sense of it, who really does bear fruit and produces, this one a hundredfold, that one sixty, the other thirty. (Matthew 13:23)
- But solid food belongs to mature people, to those who through use have their perceptive powers trained to distinguish both right and wrong. (Hebrews 5:14)
- And you must keep and do them, because this is wisdom on your part and understanding on your part before the eyes of the peoples

who will hear of all these regulations, and they will certainly say; This great nation is undoubtedly a wise and understanding people. (Deuteronomy 4:6)

- And God continued giving Solomon wisdom and understanding in very great measure and a broadness of heart, like the sand that is upon the seashore. (1 Kings 4:29)
- The getting of wisdom is O how much better than gold! And the getting of understanding is to be chosen more than silver. (Proverbs 16:16)
- The one that is wise in heart will be called understanding, and he that is sweet in his lips adds persuasiveness. (Proverbs 16:21)
- And I saw, even I, that there exists more advantage for wisdom than for folly, just as there is more advantage for light than for darkness. (Ecclesiastes 2:13)
- And as regards every matter of wisdom and understanding that the king inquired about from them, he even got to find them ten times better than all the magic-practicing priests and the conjurers that were in all his royal realm. (Daniel 1:20)
