- If, moreover, you call out for understanding itself and you give forth your voice for discernment itself. (**Proverbs 2:3**)

- This is why I tell **you**, all the things **you** pray and ask for have faith that **you** have practically received, and **you will** have them. (**Mark 11:24**)

- Therefore, if **you**, although being wicked, know how to give good gifts to **YOUR** children, how much more so **will YOUR** Father who is in the heavens give good things to those **asking** him? (**Matthew 7:11**)
- For Yehowah himself **gives wisdom**, out of his mouth there are knowledge and discernment. (**Proverbs 2:6**)
- If **you** remain in union with me and my sayings remain in **you**, ask whatever **you** wish and it **will** take place for **you**. (**John 15:7**)
- And this is the confidence that we have toward him, that, no matter what it is that we ask according to his **will**, he hears us. (**1 John 5:14**)

- At that the king answered and said; **You** men, give her the living child, and **you** must by no means put him to death. She is his mother. **(1 Kings 3:27)**
- And Yehowah, for his part, gave Solomon **wisdom**, just as he had promised him, and there came to be peace between Hiram and Solomon, and both of them proceeded to conclude a covenant. **(1 Kings 5:12)**

- But **wisdom** itself, from where does it come, and where, now, is the place of understanding? **(Job 28:20)**
- Surely it is the spirit in mortal men and the breath of the Almighty that **gives** them understanding. **(Job 32:8)**
