- James 3:17... But the wisdom from above is first of all chaste, then peaceable, reasonable, ready to obey, full of mercy and good fruits, not making partial distinctions, not hypocritical.

- Now we speak wisdom among those who are mature, but not the wisdom of this system of things nor that of the rulers of this system of things, who are to come to nothing. (1 Corinthians 2:6)
- Let YOUR love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is wicked, cling to what is good. (Romans 12:9)
- Older women as mothers, younger women as sisters with all chasteness. (1 Timothy 5:2)
- Finally, brothers, continue to rejoice, to be readjusted, to be comforted, to think in agreement, to live peaceably, and the God of love and of peace will be with you. (2 Corinthians 13:11)
- And to give them more than extraordinary consideration in love because of their work. Be peaceable with one another. (1 Thessalonians 5:13)
- But let him turn away from what is bad and do what is good, let him seek peace and pursue it. (1 Peter 3:11)
- Hence, beloved ones, since you are awaiting these things, do your utmost to be found finally by him spotless and unblemished and in peace. (2 Peter 3:14)
- Not a drunken brawler, not a smiter, but reasonable, not belligerent, not a lover of money. (1 Timothy 3:3)
- To speak injuriously of no one, not to be belligerent, to be reasonable, exhibiting all mildness toward all men. (Titus 3:2)

- On the other hand, the fruitage of the spirit is love, joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faith. (Galatians 5:22)
- But if you continue showing favoritism, you are working a sin, for you are reproved by the Law as transgressors. (James 2:9)
- Now that YOU have purified YOUR souls by YOUR obedience to the truth with unhypocritical brotherly affection as the result, love one another intensely from the heart. (1 Peter 1:22)
- As for the lowly one, you must not show preference in a controversy of his. (Exodus 23:3)
- So the king said to them; Whatever seems good in YOUR eyes I shall do. And the king kept standing at the side of the gate, and all the people themselves went out by hundreds and by thousands. (2 Samuel 18:4)
- Let me not, please, show partiality to a man, and on an earthling man I shall not bestow a title. (Job 32:21)
- True wisdom itself keeps crying aloud in the very street. In the public squares it keeps giving forth its voice. (Proverbs 1:20)
- For Yehowah himself gives wisdom, out of his mouth there are knowledge and discernment. (Proverbs 2:6)
- Acquire wisdom, acquire understanding. Do not forget, and do not turn aside from the sayings of my mouth. (Proverbs 4:5)
- Anyone loving transgression is loving a struggle. Anyone making his entryway high is seeking a crash. (Proverbs 17:19)
- And he proceeded to say to me; Son of man, please, raise your eyes in the direction of the north. So I raised my eyes in the direction of the north, and, look! To the north of the gate of the altar there was this symbol of jealousy in the entranceway. (Ezekiel 8:5)
- And you went on to prostitute yourself to the sons of Assyria because there was no satisfying of you, and you kept prostituting yourself with them and also did not get satisfaction. (Ezekiel 16:28)

- Really the objective of this mandate is love out of a clean heart and out of a good conscience and out of faith without hypocrisy. (1 Timothy 1:5)
- Likewise I desire the women to adorn themselves in wellarranged dress, with modesty and soundness of mind, not with styles of hair braiding and gold or pearls or very expensive garb. (1 Timothy 2:9)
- Let no man ever look down on your youth. On the contrary, become an example to the faithful ones in speaking, in conduct, in love, in faith, in chasteness. (1 Timothy 4:12)
- I solemnly charge you before God and Christ Jesus and the chosen angels to keep these things without prejudgment, doing nothing according to a biased leaning. (1 Timothy 5:21)
- To be sound in mind, chaste, workers at home, good, subjecting themselves to their own husbands, so that the word of God may not be spoken of abusively. (Titus 2:5)
- My brothers, you are not holding the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, our glory, with acts of favoritism, are you? (James 2:1)
- In like manner, you younger men, be in subjection to the older men. But all of you gird yourselves with lowliness of mind toward one another, because God opposes the haughty ones, but he gives undeserved kindness to the humble ones. (1 Peter 5:5)
