- But let each one prove what his own work is, and then he will have cause for exultation in regard to himself alone, and not in comparison with the other person. (**Galatians 6:4**)
- Nevertheless, a certain one will say; You have faith, and I have **works**. Show me your faith apart from the **works**, and I shall **show** you my faith by my works. (**James 2:18**)
- Foolishness is a rejoicing to one who is in want of heart, but the man of discernment is one who goes straight ahead. (**Proverbs 15:21**)
- Anyone holding back his sayings is possessed of knowledge, and a man of discernment is cool of spirit. (**Proverbs 17:27**)
- He that is trusting in his own heart is stupid, but he that is walking in **wisdom** is the one that will escape. (**Proverbs 28:26**)
- Be minded the same way toward others as to yourselves, do not be minding lofty things, but be led along with the lowly things. Do not become discreet in **YOUR** own eyes. (**Romans 12:16**)
- Go on walking in **wisdom** toward those on the outside, buying **out** the opportune time for yourselves. (**Colossians 4:5**)
- But hospitable, a lover of goodness, sound in mind, righteous, loyal, self-controlled. (**Titus 1:8**)

- Maintain **YOUR conduct fine among** the nations, that, in the thing in which they are speaking against **YOU** as evildoers, they may as a result of **YOUR fine works** of which they are eyewitnesses glorify God in the day for his inspection. (**1 Peter 2:12**)
