Men ··· Righteous ··· Wisdom And Knowledge - Wise ones use knowledge for good, the mouth of stupid ones speaks only foolishness (Proverbs 15:2) [16] - References

Proverbs 15:2" The tongue of wise ones does good with knowledge, but the mouth of the stupid ones bubbles forth with foolishness.

- My heart has become astir with a goodly matter. I am saying; My works are concerning a king. May my tongue be the stylus of a skilled copyist. (Psalms 45:1)
- The heart of the wise one causes his mouth to show insight, and to his lips it adds persuasiveness. (Proverbs 16:23)
- The words of the mouth of the wise one mean favor, but the lips of the stupid one swallow him up. (Ecclesiastes 10:12)
- The Sovereign Lord Yehowah himself has given me the tongue of the taught ones, that I may know how to answer the tired one with a word. He awakens morning by morning, he awakens my ear to hear like the taught ones. (Isaiah 50:4)
- The officers replied; Never has another man spoken like this. (John 7:46)
- Look! They make a bubbling forth with their mouth, swords are on their lips, for who is listening? (Psalms 59:7)
- Out of the same mouth come forth blessing and cursing. It is not proper, my brothers, for these things to go on occurring this way. (James 3:10)
- Then Saul's anger grew hot against Jonathan and he said to him; You son of a rebellious maid, do I not well know that you are choosing the son of Jesse to your own shame and to the shame of the secret parts of your mother? (1 Samuel 20:30)

- For a dream certainly comes in because of abundance of occupation, and the voice of a stupid one because of the abundance of words. (Ecclesiastes 5:3)
- And the foolish one speaks many words. Man does not know what will come to be, and that which will come to be after him, who can tell him? (Ecclesiastes 10:14)
