- The ear that is listening to the reproof of life lodges right in among wise people. (**Proverbs 15:31**)
- A rebuke works deeper in one having understanding than striking a stupid one a hundred times. (**Proverbs 17:10**)
- An earring of gold, and an ornament of special gold, is a wise reprover upon the hearing ear. (**Proverbs 25:12**)
- For whoever has, more **will** be given him and he **will** be made to abound, but whoever does not have, even what he has **will** be taken from him. (**Matthew 13:12**)
- Now listen to my voice. I shall advise you, and God **will** prove to be with you. You yourself serve as representative for the people before the **true** God, and you yourself must bring the cases to the **true** God. (**Exodus 18:19**)
