WISDOM - MATURE PEOPLE RECOGNIZE OUR SPEECH AS WISDOM

- ~ Paul ··· Teaching ··· Wisdom Mature people recognize our speech as wisdom, but not the same wisdom of this world and its rulers who are to come to nothing (1 Corinthians 2:6) [15] References
- Now we speak wisdom among those who are mature, but not the wisdom of this system of things nor that of the rulers of this system of things, who are to come to nothing.

[15] - References

- Brothers, do not become young children in powers of understanding, but be babes as to badness, yet become full-grown in powers of understanding. (1 Corinthians 14:20)
- Until we all attain to the oneness in the faith and in the accurate knowledge of the Son of God, to a full-grown man, to the measure of stature that belongs to the fullness of the Christ. (Ephesians 4:13)
- But solid food belongs to mature people, to those who through use have their perceptive powers trained to distinguish both right and wrong. (Hebrews 5:14)
- And again; Yehowah knows that the reasonings of the wise men are futile. (1 Corinthians 3:20)
- For the thing we boast of is this, to which our conscience bears witness, that with holiness and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom but with God's undeserved kindness, we have conducted ourselves in the world, but more especially toward you. (2 Corinthians 1:12)
- O Timothy, guard what is laid up in trust with you, turning away from the empty speeches that violate what is holy and from the contradictions of the falsely called knowledge. (1 Timothy 6:20)
- But Jesus, calling them to him, said; You know that the rulers of the nations lord it over them and the great men wield authority over them. (Matthew 20:25)
- Next, the end, when he hands over the kingdom to his God and Father, when he has brought to nothing all government and all authority and power. (1 Corinthians 15:24)

- After that Pharaoh said to Joseph; Since God has caused you to know all this, there is no one as discreet and wise as you are. (Genesis 41:39)
- Listen, for it is about the foremost things that I speak, and the opening of my lips is about uprightness. (Proverbs 8:6)
- In that very hour he became overjoyed in the Holy Spirit and said; I publicly praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have carefully hidden these things from wise and intellectual ones, and have revealed them to babes. Yes, O Father, because to do thus came to be the way approved by you. (Luke 10:21)
- And God chose the ignoble things of the world and the things looked down upon, the things that are not, that he might bring to nothing the things that are. (1 Corinthians 1:28)
- Far above every government and authority and power and lordship and every name named, not only in this system of things, but also in that to come. (Ephesians 1:21)
- Let us, then, as many of us as are mature, be of this mental attitude, and if you are mentally inclined otherwise in any respect, God will reveal the above attitude to you. (Philippians 3:15)
- But the wisdom from above is first of all chaste, then peaceable, reasonable, ready to obey, full of mercy and good fruits, not making partial distinctions, not hypocritical. (James 3:17)
