WISDOM - WHO IS WISE DISCREET

Men ··· Righteous ··· Wisdom - Who is wise so as to understand these things, discreet that he may know them, for the ways of Yehowah are upright and the righteous ones will walk in them but the transgressors will stumble in them (Hosea 14:9) [18] - References

Hosea 14:9... Who is wise, that he may understand these things? Discreet, that he may know them? For the ways of Yehowah are upright, and the righteous are the ones who will walk in them, but the transgressors are the ones who will stumble in them.

[18] - References

- Who is wise? He will both observe these things and show himself attentive toward Yehowah's acts of loving-kindness. (Psalms 107:43)
- A wise person will listen and take in more instruction, and a man of understanding is the one who acquires skillful direction. (Proverbs 1:5)
- Who is the man that is wise, that he may understand this, even the one to whom the mouth of Yehowah has spoken, that he may tell it? On what account should the land actually perish, be actually burned like the wilderness without anyone passing through? (Jeremiah 9:12)
- Who really is the faithful and discreet slave whom his master appointed over his domestics, to give them their food at the proper time? (Matthew 24:45)
- The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice. Righteous and upright is he. (Deuteronomy 32:4)
- Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, am praising and exalting and glorifying the King of the heavens, because all his works are truth and his ways are justice, and because those who are walking in pride he is able to humiliate. (Daniel 4:37)

- They both were righteous before God because of walking blamelessly in accord with all the commandments and legal requirements of Yehowah. (Luke 1:6)
- Many will cleanse themselves and whiten themselves and will be refined. And the wicked ones will certainly act wickedly, and no wicked ones at all will understand, but the ones having insight will understand. (Daniel 12:10)
- O that they were wise! Then they would ponder over this. They would consider their end afterward. (Deuteronomy 32:29)
- And his heart became bold in the ways of Yehowah, and he even removed the high places and the sacred poles from Judah. (2 Chronicles 17:6)
- And Haman went on to relate to Zeresh his wife and to all his friends everything that had befallen him. At that his wise men and Zeresh his wife said to him; If it is from the seed of the Jews that Mordecai is before whom you have started to fall, you will not prevail against him, but you will without fail fall before him. (Esther 6:13)
- His ways keep prospering all the time. Your judicial decisions are high up out of his range, as for all those showing hostility to him, he puffs at them. (Psalms 10:5)
- And all earthling men will become afraid, and they will tell of the activity of God, and they will certainly have insight into his work. (Psalms 64:9)
- For the thoughts of you people are not my thoughts, nor are my ways your ways, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Isaiah 55:8)
- You have met up with the one exulting and doing righteousness, those who keep remembering you in your own ways. Look! You yourself became indignant, while we kept sinning, in them a long time, and should we be saved? (Isaiah 64:5)
- I shall not hold an accounting against YOUR daughters because they commit fornication, and against YOUR daughters-in-law because they commit adultery. For, as to the men, it is with the harlots that they get off to themselves, and with the female temple prostitutes that they sacrifice, and a people that does not understand will be trodden down. (Hosea 4:14)

- But now, please, set YOUR heart on this from this day and forward, before there was the placing of a stone upon a stone in the temple of Yehowah. (Haggai 2:15)
