- And **YOU** must keep and do them, because this is wisdom on **YOUR** part and understanding on **YOUR** part before the eyes of the peoples who will hear of all these regulations, and they will certainly say; This great nation is undoubtedly a wise and understanding people. (**Deuteronomy 4:6**)

(**Jeremiah 9:24**)

- O that they were wise! Then they would ponder over this. They would consider their end afterward. (**Deuteronomy 32:29**)
