- A son is wise where there is a father's discipline, but the ridiculer is one that has not heard rebuke. (Proverbs 13:1)
- The father of a righteous one will without fail be joyful, the one becoming father to a wise one will also rejoice in him. (Proverbs 23:24)
- Be wise, my son, and make my heart rejoice, that I may make a reply to him that is taunting me. (Proverbs 27:11)
- A man that is loving wisdom makes his father rejoice, but he that is having companionship with prostitutes destroys valuable things. (Proverbs 29:3)
- A wise son is the one that makes a father rejoice, but a stupid man is despising his mother. (Proverbs 15:20)
- Anyone becoming father to a stupid child, it is a grief to him, and the father of a senseless child does not rejoice. (Proverbs 17:21)
- A stupid son is a vexation to his father and a bitterness to her that gave him birth. (Proverbs 17:25)
