Proverbs 24:23. These sayings also are for the wise ones; The showing of partiality in judgment is not good.

[16] - References

- And all Israel got to hear of the judicial decision that the king had handed down, and they became fearful because of the king, for they saw that the wisdom of God was within him to execute judicial decision. (1 Kings 3:28)
- And you, Ezra, according to the wisdom of your God that is in your hand appoint magistrates and judges that they may continually judge all the people that are beyond the River, even all those knowing the Laws of your God, and anyone that has not known them you men will instruct. (Ezra 7:25)
- Who is wise? He will both observe these things and show himself attentive toward Yehowah's acts of loving-kindness. (Psalms 107:43)
- You people must not do injustice in the judgment. You must not treat the lowly with partiality, and you must not prefer the person of a great one. With justice you should judge your associate. (Leviticus 19:15)
- You must not be partial in judgment. You should hear the little one the same as the great one. You must not become frightened because of a man, for the judgment belongs to God, and the case that is too hard for you, you should present to me, and I must hear it. (Deuteronomy 1:17)
- You must not pervert judgment. You must not be partial or accept a bribe, for the bribe blinds the eyes of wise ones and distorts the words of righteous ones. (Deuteronomy 16:19)

- And now let the dread of Yehowah come to be upon You. Be careful and act, for with Yehowah our God there is no unrighteousness or partiality or taking of a bribe. (2 Chronicles 19:7)
- I solemnly charge you before God and Christ Jesus and the chosen angels to keep these things without prejudgment, doing nothing according to a biased leaning. (1 Timothy 5:21)
- You have class distinctions among yourselves and you have become judges rendering wicked decisions, is that not so? (James 2:4)
- Furthermore, if you are calling upon the Father who judges impartially according to each one's work, conduct yourselves with fear during the time of your alien residence. (1 Peter 1:17)
- That anyone that would not search for Yehowah the God of Israel should be put to death, whether small or great, whether man or woman. (2 Chronicles 15:13)
- Will you be treating him with partiality, or for the true God will you contend at Law? (Job 13:8)
- Let me not, please, show partiality to a man, and on an earthling man I shall not bestow a title. (Job 32:21)
- The showing of partiality to the wicked one is not good, nor the turning aside of the righteous one in judgment. (Proverbs 18:5)
- Stop judging from the outward appearance, but judge with righteous judgment. (John 7:24)
- My brothers, you are not holding the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, our glory, with acts of favoritism, are you? (James 2:1)
