Isaiah 5:21... Woe to those wise in their own eyes and discreet even in front of their own faces!

[13] - References

- Although asserting they were wise, they became foolish. (Romans 1:22)
- At that time Jesus said in response; I publicly praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and intellectual ones and have revealed them to babes. (Matthew 11:25)
- Yes, O Father, because to do thus came to be the way approved by you. (Matthew 11:26)
- Do not become wise in your own eyes. Fear Yehowah and turn away from bad. (Proverbs 3:7)
- The ridiculer does not love the one reproving him. To the wise ones he will not go. (Proverbs 15:12)
- Jesus said to them; If you were blind, you would have no sin. But now you say; We see. Your sin remains. (John 9:41)
- Although asserting they were wise, they became foolish (Romans 1:22)
- Be minded the same way toward others as to yourselves, do not be minding lofty things, but be led along with the lowly things. Do not become discreet in YOUR own eyes. (Romans 12:16)
- LET them be. Blind guides is what they are. If, then, a blind man guides a blind man, both will fall into a pit. (Matthew 15:14)
- For a fact you men are the people, and with you wisdom will die out! (Job 12:2)

- Do not toil to gain riches. Cease from your own understanding. (Proverbs 23:4)
- A rich man is wise in his own eyes, but the lowly one who is discerning searches him through. (Proverbs 28:11)
