**John 5:36**... But I have the witness greater than that of John, for the very works that my Father assigned me to accomplish, the works themselves that I am doing, bear witness about me that the Father dispatched me.

- The blind are seeing again, and the lame are walking **about**, the lepers are being cleansed and the deaf are hearing, and the dead are being raised up, and the poor are having the Good News declared to them. (**Matthew 11:5**)
- This one came to him in the night and said to him; Rabbi, we know that you as a teacher have come from God, for no one can perform these signs that you perform unless God is with him. (**John 3:2**)
- Still, many of the crowd put faith in him, and they commenced saying; When the Christ arrives, he will not perform more signs than this man has performed, will he? (**John 7:31**)
- Jesus answered them; I told **you**, and yet **you** do not believe. The **works** that I **am doing** in the name of my **Father**, these **bear witness about** me. (**John 10:25**)
- Then Moses said; By this **you** will know that Yehowah has sent me to do all these deeds, that it is not of my own heart. (**Numbers 16:28**)
- He was not that light, but he was meant to **bear witness about** that light. (**John 1:8**)
- Jesus said to them; My food is for me to do the will of him that sent me and to finish his work. (**John 4:34**)

- If this man were not from God, he could do nothing at all. (John 9:33)
- If I **am** not **doing** the **works** of my **Father**, do not believe me. (John 10:37)
- Believe me that I **am** in union with the **Father** and the **Father** is in union with me, otherwise, believe on account of the **works** themselves. (John 14:11)
- Jesus, therefore, said to them again; May **you** have peace. Just as the **Father** has sent me forth, I also **am** sending **you**. (John 20:21)
- Men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus the Nazarene, a man publicly shown by God to **you** through powerful **works** and portents and signs that God did through him in **your** midst, just as **you** yourselves know. (Acts of Apostles 2:22)
- **You** yourselves are our letter, inscribed on our hearts and known and being read by all mankind. (2 Corinthians 3:2)
