- You are indeed more handsome than the **sons** of men. Charm has been poured **out** upon your lips. That is why God has blessed you to time indefinite. **(Psalms 45:2)**
- The Sovereign Lord Yehowah himself has given me the tongue of the taught ones, that I may know how to answer the tired one with a word. He awakens morning by morning, he awakens my ear to hear like the taught ones. **(Isaiah 50:4)**
- Let a rotten **saying** not proceed **out** of **YOUR mouth**, but whatever **saying** is good for building up as the need may be, that it may impart what is **favorable** to the hearers. **(Ephesians 4:29)**
- And after coming into his home territory he began to teach them in their synagogue, so that they were astounded and said; Where did this man get this wisdom and these powerful works? **(Matthew 13:54)**
- When it became Sabbath, he started teaching in the synagogue, and the greater number of those listening were astounded and said; Where did this man get these things? And why should this wisdom have been given this man, and such powerful works be performed through his hands? **(Mark 6:2)**
- And they began **saying**; Is this not Jesus the **son** of **Joseph**, whose father and mother we know? How is it that now he says, I have come down from heaven? **(John 6:42)**
- Their judges have been thrown down by the sides of the crag, but they have heard my **sayings**, that they are pleasant. **(Psalms 141:6)**

- On the lips of the understanding person wisdom is found, but the rod is for the back of one in want of heart. (**Proverbs 10:13**)
- The one that is wise in heart will be called understanding, and he that is sweet in his lips adds persuasiveness. (**Proverbs 16:21**)
