- You are indeed more handsome than the sons of men. Charm has been poured out upon your lips. That is why God has blessed you to time indefinite. (Psalms 45:2)
- The Sovereign Lord Yehowah himself has given me the tongue of the taught ones, that I may know how to answer the tired one with a word. He awakens morning by morning, he awakens my ear to hear like the taught ones. (Isaiah 50:4)
- Let a rotten saying not proceed out of Your mouth, but whatever saying is good for building up as the need may be, that it may impart what is favorable to the hearers. (Ephesians 4:29)
