- He reported to us how he saw the angel stand in his house and say; Dispatch men to Joppa and send for Simon who is surnamed Peter. (**Acts of Apostles 11:13**)
- Simon Peter, a slave and apostle of Jesus Christ, to those who have obtained a faith, held in equal privilege with ours, by the righteousness of our **God** and the Savior Jesus Christ. (**2 Peter 1:1**)
- Look! A nation that you do not know you will call, and those of a nation who have not known you will run even to you, for the sake of Yehowah your **God**, and for the Holy One of Israel, because he will have beautified you. (**Isaiah 55:5**)
- But **you** are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a **people** for special possession, that **you** should declare abroad the excellencies of the one that called **you out** of darkness into his wonderful light. (**1 Peter 2:9**)
- And I used to appear to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob as **God** Almighty, but as respects my **name** Yehowah I did not make myself known to them. (**Exodus 6:3**)
- And you will provide me escape from the faultfinding of my **people**. You will safeguard me to be the head of **nations**, a **people** that I have not known, they will serve me. (**2 Samuel 22:44**)
- You will provide me escape from the faultfinding of the **people**. You will appoint me the head of the **nations**. A **people** that I have not known, they will serve me. (**Psalms 18:43**)

- Turn to me and show me favor, according to your judicial decision toward those loving your **name**. (**Psalms 119:132**)
- For that reason my **people** will know my **name**, even for that reason in that day, because I am the One that is speaking. Look! It is I. (**Isaiah 52:6**)
- We have for a long time become as those over whom you did not rule, as those upon whom your **name** had not been called. (**Isaiah 63:19**)
- The **names** of the twelve apostles are these; First, Simon, the one called Peter, and Andrew his brother, and James the son of Zebedee and John his brother. (**Matthew 10:2**)
- He led him to Jesus. When Jesus looked upon him he said; You are Simon the son of John, you will be called Cephas, which is translated Peter. (**John 1:42**)
- I have made your **name** manifest to the men you gave me **out** of the world. They were yours, and you gave them to me, and they have observed your word. (**John 17:6**)
- Through whom we received undeserved kindness and an apostleship in order, that there might be obedience of faith among all the **nations** respecting his **name**. (**Romans 1:5**)
- But glory and honor and peace for everyone who works what is good, for the Jew **first** and also for the Greek. (**Romans 2:10**)
- You will say, then; Branches were broken off that I might be grafted in. (**Romans 11:19**)
- For **you** were once not a **people**, but are now God's **people**, **you** were those who had not been shown mercy, but are now those who have been shown mercy. (**1 Peter 2:10**)
