- Now when Paul took note that the one part was of Sadducees but the other of Pharisees, he proceeded to cry out in the Sanhedrin; Men, brothers, I am a Pharisee, a son of Pharisees. Over the **hope of resurrection** of the dead I am being judged. (**Acts of Apostles 23:6**)
- Your dead ones will live. A corpse of mine, they will rise up. Awake and cry out joyfully, **you** residents in the dust! For your dew is as the dew of mallows, and the earth itself will let even those impotent in death drop in birth. (**Isaiah 26:19**)
- And there will be many of those asleep in the ground of dust who will wake up, these to indefinitely lasting life and those to reproaches and to indefinitely lasting abhorrence. (**Daniel 12:2**)
- As regards the **resurrection** of the dead, did **you** not read what was spoken to **you** by **God**, saying; (**Matthew 22:31**)
- Do not marvel at this, because the hour is coming in which all those in the memorial tombs will hear his voice (**John 5:28**)
- Jesus said to her; I am the **resurrection** and the life. He that exercises faith in me, even though he dies, will come to life. (**John 11:25**)
- And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and scrolls were opened. But another scroll was opened, it is the scroll of life. And the dead were judged out of those things written in the scrolls according to their deeds. (**Revelation 20:12**)

- And you will be happy, because they have nothing with which to repay you. For you will be repaid in the **resurrection** of the **righteous** ones. (**Luke 14:14**)
- Women received their dead by **resurrection**, but other **men** were tortured because they would not accept release by some ransom, in order, that they might attain a better **resurrection**. (**Hebrews 11:35**)
- And he said to him; Truly I tell you today, you will be with me in Paradise. (**Luke 23:43**)
- And as for you yourself, go **toward** the end, and you will rest, but you will stand up for your lot at the end of the days. (**Daniel 12:13**)
- Let your kingdom come. Let your will take place, as in heaven, also upon earth. (**Matthew 6:10**)
- But those who have been counted worthy of gaining that system of things and the **resurrection** from the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage. (**Luke 20:35**)
- Martha said to him; I know he will rise in the **resurrection** on the last day. (**John 11:24**)
- And yet now for the **hope** of the promise that was made by **God** to our forefathers I stand called to judgment. (**Acts of Apostles 26:6**)
- For the creation was subjected to futility, not by its own will but through him that subjected it, on the basis of **hope** (**Romans 8:20**)
- The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were ended. This is the first **resurrection**. (**Revelation 20:5**)
