Acts of Apostles 20:24. Nevertheless, I do not make my soul of any account as dear to me, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received of the Lord Jesus, to bear thorough witness to the Good News of the undeserved kindness of God.

- Who will separate us from the love of the Christ? Will tribulation or distress or persecution or hunger or nakedness or danger or sword? (Romans 8:35)
- Therefore we do not give up, but even if the man we are outside is wasting away, certainly the man we are inside is being renewed from day to day. (2 Corinthians 4:16)
- I have fought the fine fight, I have run the course to the finish, I have observed the faith. (2 Timothy 4:7)
- That is why, since we have this ministry according to the mercy that was shown us, we do not give up. (2 Corinthians 4:1)
- But all things are from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of the reconciliation. (2 Corinthians 5:18)
- Paul, an apostle, neither from men nor through a man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised him up from the dead. (Galatians 1:1)
- Working together with him, we also entreat you not to accept the undeserved kindness of God and miss its purpose. (2 Corinthians 6:1)
- And he proceeded to put his soul in his palm and strike the Philistine down, so that Yehowah performed a great salvation for all Israel. You saw it, and you gave way to rejoicing. So why should you

sin against innocent blood in having David put to death for nothing? (1 Samuel 19:5)

- For whoever wants to save his soul will lose it, but whoever loses his soul for my sake is the one that will save it. (Luke 9:24)
- Moreover, I say to YOU, my friends; Do not fear those who kill the body and after this are not able to do anything more. (Luke 12:4)
- Then Paul answered; What are you doing by weeping and making me weak at heart? Rest assured, I am ready not only to be bound but also to die at Jerusalem for the name of the Lord Jesus. (Acts of Apostles 21:13)
- For me to be a public servant of Christ Jesus to the nations, engaging in the holy work of the Good News of God, in order, that the offering, namely, these nations, might prove to be acceptable, it being sanctified with Holy Spirit. (Romans 15:16)
- And with supplication for you they long for you because of the surpassing undeserved kindness of God upon you. (2 Corinthians 9:14)
- Because on account of the Lord's work he came quite near to death, exposing his soul to danger, that he might fully make up for your not being here to render private service to me. (Philippians 2:30)
- And they conquered him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their witnessing, and they did not love their souls even in the face of death. (Revelation 12:11)
