~ **Witness ... Paul ... Jews** - They kept opposing and speaking abusively, so Paul said to them; Let your blood be upon your own heads, I am clean, From now on I will go to the people of the nations·
(Acts of Apostles 18:6) [18] - References

Acts of Apostles 18:6· But after they kept on opposing and speaking abusively, he shook out his garments and said to them; Let **YOUR** blood be upon **YOUR** own heads. I am clean. From now on I will go to people of the nations.

[18] - References

- Because **YOU** do not continue running with them in this course to the same low sink of debauchery, they are puzzled and **go on speaking abusively** of **you**. (1 Peter 4:4)
- Wherever anyone does not take **YOU** in or listen to **YOUR** words, on going **out** of that house or that city shake the dust off **YOUR** feet.
(Matthew 10:14)
- These **shook** the dust off their feet against them and went to Iconium. (Acts of Apostles 13:51)
- And it must occur that on the day of your going **out** and when you do pass over the torrent valley of Kidron, you should unmistakably know that you **will** positively die. Bloodguilt for you **will** itself come to be upon your **own** head. (1 Kings 2:37)
- On usury he has given, and interest he has taken, and he positively **will** not keep living. All these detestable things he has done. He **will** positively be put to death. On him his **own blood will** come to be. (Ezekiel 18:13)
- And the hearer actually hears the sound of the horn but he takes no warning at all, and a sword comes and takes him away, his **own blood will** come to be upon his **own** head. (Ezekiel 33:4)
- When I say to someone wicked; You **will** positively die, and you do not actually warn him and speak in order to warn the wicked one from his wicked way to preserve him alive, he being wicked, in his

error he **will** die, but his **blood** I shall ask back from your **own** hand. (Ezekiel 3:18)

- Hence I call **you** to witness this very day that I **am clean** from the **blood** of all men. (Acts of Apostles 20:26)

- And so, talking with boldness, Paul and Barnabas **said**; It was necessary for the word of God to be spoken first to **you**. Since **you** are thrusting it away from **you** and do not judge yourselves worthy of everlasting life, look! we turn to the nations. (Acts of Apostles 13:46)

- Therefore let it be known to **you** that this, the means by which God saves, has been sent **out** to the nations, they **will** certainly listen to it. (Acts of Apostles 28:28)

- For I **am** not ashamed of the Good News, it is, in fact, God's power for salvation to everyone having faith, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. (Romans 1:16)

- David then **said** to him; The bloodguilt for you be upon your **own** head, because your **own** mouth has testified against you, saying; I myself definitely put the anointed of Yehowah to death. (2 Samuel 1:16)

- Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God the God of my salvation, that my tongue may joyfully tell about your righteousness. (Psalms 51:14)

- But as for you, in case you have warned someone wicked and he does not actually turn back from his wickedness and from his wicked way, he himself for his error **will** die, but as for you, you **will** have delivered your **own** soul. (Ezekiel 3:19)

- And as for you, in case you have warned someone righteous that the righteous one should not sin, and he himself does not actually sin, he **will** without fail keep on living because he had been warned, and you yourself **will** have delivered your **own** soul. (Ezekiel 3:21)

- But as regards you, in case you actually warn someone wicked from his way for him to turn back from it but he actually does not turn back from his way, he himself **will** die in his **own** error, whereas you yourself **will** certainly deliver your **own** soul. (Ezekiel 33:9)

- They **said** to him; Because they are evil, he **will** bring an evil destruction upon them and **will** let **out** the vineyard to other cultivators, who **will** render him the fruits when they become due. (Matthew 21:41)

- Even the dust that got stuck to our feet from **YOUR** city we wipe off against **YOU**. Nevertheless, keep this in mind, that the kingdom of God has come near. (**Luke 10:11**)
