~ **Witness** ... **Paul** ... Seeing that we are the progeny of God we ought not to imagine that God is like gold or silver or stone made into any form that we as men might contrive' (**Acts of Apostles 17:29**) ^[28] -

Acts of Apostles 17:29... Seeing, therefore, that we are the progeny of God, we ought not to imagine that the Divine Being is like gold or silver or stone, like something sculptured by the art and contrivance of man.

- And **God** proceeded to create the **man** in his image, in God's image he created him, male and female he created them. (**Genesis 1:27**)
- **Divine** One, **God**, Yehowah, **Divine** One, **God**, Yehowah, he is knowing, and Israel, he too will know. If it is in rebellion and if it is in unfaithfulness against Yehowah, do not save us this day. (**Joshua 22:22**)
- The **Divine** One, **God**, Yehowah, has himself spoken, and he proceeds to call the earth, from the rising of the sun until its setting. (**Psalms 50:1**)
- Remember the first things of a long time ago, that I am the **Divine** One and there is no other **God**, nor anyone like me. (**Isaiah 46:9**)
- You must not make for yourself a carved image, any form like anything that is in the heavens above or that is on the earth underneath or that is in the waters under the earth. (**Deuteronomy 5:8**)
- And there was a consigning of their gods to the fire, because they were no gods, but the workmanship of man's hands, wood and **stone**, so that they destroyed them. (**Isaiah 37:19**)
- And to whom can **you** people liken **God**, and what likeness can **you** put alongside him? (**Isaiah 40:18**)
- To whom will **you** people liken me or make me equal or compare me that we may resemble each other? (**Isaiah 46:5**)

- Also, **you** behold and hear how not only in Ephesus but in nearly all the district of Asia this Paul has persuaded a considerable crowd and turned them to another opinion, saying that the ones that are made by hands are not gods. (**Acts of Apostles 19:26**)
- And **God** went on to say; Let us make **man** in our image, according to our likeness, and let them have in subjection the fish of the sea and the flying creatures of the heavens and the domestic animals and all the earth and every moving animal that is moving upon the earth. (**Genesis 1:26**)
- You must not make for yourself a carved image or a form like anything that is in the heavens above or that is on the earth underneath or that is in the waters under the earth. (**Exodus 20:4**)
- **You** must not make along with me gods of **silver**, and **you** must not make gods of **gold** for yourselves. (**Exodus 20:23**)
- Meanwhile the people got to see that Moses was taking a long time about coming down from the mountain. So the people congregated themselves about Aaron and said to him; Get up, make for us a god who will go ahead of us, because as regards this Moses, the **man** who led us up out of the land of Egypt, we certainly do not know what has happened to him. (**Exodus 32:1**)
- So they said to me; Make for us a god who will go ahead of us, because as regards this Moses, the **man** who led us up out of the land of Egypt, we certainly do not know what has happened to him. (**Exodus 32:23**)
- **You** must not make valueless gods for yourselves, and **you** must not set up a carved image or a sacred pillar for yourselves, and **you** must not put a **stone** as a showpiece in **YOUR** land in order to bow down toward it, for I am Yehowah **YOUR God**. (**Leviticus 26:1**)
- That **you** may not act ruinously and may not really make for yourselves a carved image, the form of any symbol, the representation of male or female. (**Deuteronomy 4:16**)
- Consequently the king took counsel and made two golden calves and said to the people; It is too much for **you** to go up to Jerusalem. Here is your **God**, O Israel, that brought you up out of the land of Egypt. (**1 Kings 12:28**)
- And they have consigned their gods to the fire, because they were no gods, but the workmanship of man's hands, wood and **stone**, so that they destroyed them. (**2 Kings 19:18**)

- Hands are theirs, but they cannot feel. Feet are theirs, but they cannot walk, they utter no sound with their throat. (**Psalms 115:7**)
- The idols of the nations are **silver** and **gold**, the work of the hands of earthling **man**. (**Psalms 135:15**)
- As for the wood carver, he has stretched out the measuring line, he traces it out with red chalk, he works it up with a wood scraper, and with a compass he keeps tracing it out, and gradually he makes it like the representation of a **man**, like the beauty of mankind, to sit in a house. (**Isaiah 44:13**)
- Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of **gold**, the height of which was sixty cubits and the breadth of which was six cubits. He set it up in the plain of Dura in the jurisdictional district of Babylon. (**Daniel 3:1**)
- They drank wine, and they praised the gods of **gold** and of **silver**, copper, iron, wood and **stone**. (**Daniel 5:4**)
- But against the Lord of the heavens you exalted yourself, and they brought before you even the vessels of his house, and you yourself and your grandees, your concubines and your secondary wives have been drinking wine from them, and you have praised mere gods of **silver** and of **gold**, copper, iron, wood and **stone**, that are beholding nothing or hearing nothing or knowing nothing, but the **God** in whose hand your breath is and to whom all your ways belong you have not glorified. (**Daniel 5:23**)
- Woe to the one saying to the piece of wood; O do awake! to a dumb **stone**; O wake up! It itself will give instruction! Look! It is sheathed in **gold** and **silver**, and there is no breath at all in the midst of it. (**Habakkuk 2:19**)
- And turned the glory of the incorruptible **God** into something like the image of corruptible **man** and of birds and four-footed creatures and creeping things. (**Romans 1:23**)
- Because it is in him that all the fullness of the divine quality dwells bodily. (**Colossians 2:9**)
- Through these things he has freely given us the precious and very grand promises, that through these **you** may become sharers in divine nature, having escaped from the corruption that is in the world through lust. (**2 Peter 1:4**)
