Acts of Apostles 17:24... The God that made the world and all the things in it, being, as this One is, Lord of heaven and earth, does not dwell in handmade temples,

^[14] - References

- The Maker of **heaven** and **earth**, of the sea, and of all that is in them, the **One** keeping trueness to time indefinite. (**Psalms 146:6**)
- This is what the true God, Yehowah, has said, the Creator of the **heavens** and the Grand **One** stretching them out, the **One** laying out the **earth** and its produce, the **One** giving breath to the people on it, and spirit to those walking in it. (**Isaiah 42:5**)
- Upon hearing this they with one accord raised their voices to God and said; Sovereign **Lord**, you are the **One** who **made** the **heaven** and the **earth** and the sea and all the **things** in them. (**Acts of Apostles 4:24**)
- And saying; Men, why are **you** doing these **things**? We also are humans having the same infirmities as **you** do, and are declaring the Good News to **you**, for **you** to turn from these vain **things** to the living God, who **made** the **heaven** and the **earth** and the sea and all the **things** in them. (**Acts of Apostles 14:15**)
- But will God truly **dwell** upon the **earth**? Look! The **heavens**, yes, the **heaven** of the **heavens**, themselves cannot contain you, how much less, then, this house that I have built! (**1 Kings 8:27**)
- This is what Yehowah has said; The **heavens** are my throne, and the **earth** is my footstool. Where, then, is the house that **you** people can build for me, and where, then, is the place as a resting-place for me? (**Isaiah 66:1**)
- Nevertheless, the Most High does not **dwell** in houses **made** with hands, just as the prophet says. (**Acts of Apostles 7:48**)

- And who could retain power to build him a house? For the **heavens** and the **heaven** of the **heavens** cannot contain him, and who am I that I should build him a house except for making sacrificial smoke before him? (**2 Chronicles 2:6**)
- And Hiram went on to say; Blessed be Yehowah the God of Israel, who **made** the **heavens** and the **earth**, because he has given to David the king a wise son, experienced in discretion and understanding, who will build a house to Yehowah and a house for his kingship. (**2 Chronicles 2:12**)
- But will God truly **dwell** with mankind upon the **earth**? Look! Heaven, yes, the **heaven** of the **heavens** themselves, cannot contain you, how much less, then, this house that I have built? (**2 Chronicles 6:18**)
- For to me belongs every wild animal of the forest, the beasts upon a thousand mountains. (**Psalms 50:10**)
- Know that Yehowah is God. It is he that has **made** us, and not we ourselves. We are his people and the sheep of his pasturage. (**Psalms 100:3**)
- My help is from Yehowah, the Maker of **heaven** and **earth**. (**Psalms 121:2**)
- Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, am praising and exalting and glorifying the King of the **heavens**, because all his works are truth and his ways are justice, and because those who are walking in pride he is able to humiliate. (**Daniel 4:37**)
