Witness ... Peter ... Cornelius - How God anointed Jesus from Nazareth with Holy Spirit and power and he went through the land doing good and healing all those oppressed by the Devil because God was with him (Acts of Apostles 10:38) [26] - References

Acts of Apostles 10:38. Namely, Jesus who was from Nazareth, how God anointed him with Holy Spirit and power, and he went through the land doing good and healing all those oppressed by the Devil, because God was with him.

- And upon him the spirit of Yehowah must settle down, the spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the spirit of counsel and of mightiness, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of Yehowah. (Isaiah 11:2)
- Look! My servant, on whom I keep fast hold! My chosen one, whom my soul has approved! I have put my spirit in him. Justice to the nations is what he will bring forth. (Isaiah 42:1)
- The spirit of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah is upon me, for the reason that Yehowah has anointed me to tell Good News to the meek ones. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to those taken captive and the wide opening of the eyes even to the prisoners. (Isaiah 61:1)
- After being baptized Jesus immediately came up from the water, and, look! the heavens were opened up, and he saw descending like a dove God's spirit coming upon him. (Matthew 3:16)
- You loved righteousness, and you hated Lawlessness. That is why God, your God, anointed you with the oil of exultation more than your partners. (Hebrews 1:9)
- Was it not due, then, for this woman who is a daughter of Abraham, and whom Satan held bound, look! Eighteen years, to be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath day? (Luke 13:16)
- This one came to him in the night and said to him; Rabbi, we know that you as a teacher have come from God, for no one can

perform these signs that you perform unless God is with him. (John 3:2)

- And with them you must clothe Aaron your brother and his sons with him, and you must anoint them and fill their hand with power and sanctify them, and they must act as priests to me. (Exodus 28:41)
- And you must take the anointing oil and pour it upon his head and anoint him. (Exodus 29:7)
- And you will anoint Aaron and his sons, and you must sanctify them for acting as priests to me. (Exodus 30:30)
- And you must clothe Aaron with the holy garments and anoint him and sanctify him, and so he must act as priest to me. (Exodus 40:13)
- This is the offering of Aaron and his sons that they will present to Yehowah on the day of his being anointed, the tenth of an ephah of fine flour as a grain offering constantly, half of it in the morning and half of it in the evening. (Leviticus 6:20)
- Finally he poured some of the anointing oil upon Aaron's head and anointed him so as to sanctify him. (Leviticus 8:12)
- And the priest who will be anointed and whose hand will be filled with power to act as priest as successor of his father must make an atonement and must put on the linen garments. They are holy garments. (Leviticus 16:32)
- He should also not go out from the sanctuary and not profane the sanctuary of his God, because the sign of dedication, the anointing oil of his God, is upon him. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 21:12)
- As for Yehowah, those contending against him will be terrified, Against them he will thunder in the heavens. Yehowah himself will judge the ends of the earth, that he may give strength to his king, that he may exalt the horn of his anointed one. (1 Samuel 2:10)
- Here I am. Answer against me in front of Yehowah and in front of his anointed one; Whose bull have I taken or whose ass have I taken or whom have I defrauded or whom have I crushed or from whose hand have I accepted hush money that I should hide my eyes with it? And I shall make restoration to you people. (1 Samuel 12:3)
- You have loved righteousness and you hate wickedness. That is why God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of exultation more than your partners. (Psalms 45:7)

- I have found David my servant, with my holy oil I have anointed him. (Psalms 89:20)
- Accordingly he answered and said to me; This is the word of Yehowah to Zerubbabel, saying, Not by a military force, nor by power, but by my spirit, Yehowah of armies has said. (Zechariah 4:6)
- Then he went around throughout the whole of Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and preaching the Good News of the kingdom and curing every sort of disease and every sort of infirmity among the people. (Matthew 4:23)
- Jesus, now noticing that a crowd was running together upon them, rebuked the unclean spirit, saying to it; You speechless and deaf spirit, I order you, get out of him and enter into him no more. (Mark 9:25)
- Furthermore, Jesus himself, when he commenced his work, was about thirty years old, being the son, as the opinion was, of Joseph, son of Heli. (Luke 3:23)
- Accordingly he went on preaching in the synagogues of Judea. (Luke 4:44)
- Even so, both Herod and Pontius Pilate with men of nations and with peoples of Israel were in actuality gathered together in this city against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed. (Acts of Apostles 4:27)
- The spirit and the water and the blood, and the three are in agreement. (1 John 5:8)
