WITNESSES - PETER - THE GOD OF ABRAHAM HAS GLORIFIED

Witness ... Peter ... The God of Abraham had glorified his servant Jesus whom you for your part delivered up and disowned before Pilate when he himself had decided to release him (Acts of Apostles 3:13) [26] - References

Acts of Apostles 3:13... The God of Abraham and of Isaac and of Jacob, the God of our forefathers, has glorified his Servant, Jesus, whom you, for YOUR part, delivered up and disowned before Pilate's face, when he had decided to release him.

[26] - References

- And he went on to say; I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob. Then Moses concealed his face, because he was afraid to look at the true God. (Exodus 3:6)
- I am the God of Abraham and the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob? He is the God, not of the dead, but of the living. (Matthew 22:32)
- However, he said this concerning the spirit which those who put faith in him were about to receive, for as yet there was no spirit, because Jesus had not yet been glorified. (John 7:39)
- For this very reason also God exalted him to a superior position and kindly gave him the name that is above every other name. (Philippians 2:9)
- Look! My servant will act with insight. He will be in high station and will certainly be elevated and exalted very much. (Isaiah 52:13)
- Because of the trouble of his soul he will see, he will be satisfied. By means of his knowledge the righteous one, my servant, will bring a righteous standing to many people, and their errors he himself will bear. (Isaiah 53:11)
- This man, as one delivered up by the determined counsel and foreknowledge of God, you fastened to a stake by the hand of Lawless men and did away with. (Acts of Apostles 2:23)

- The God of our forefathers raised up Jesus, whom you slew, hanging him upon a stake. (Acts of Apostles 5:30)
- Now in responding the governor said to them; Which of the two do you want me to release to you? They said; Barabbas. (Matthew 27:21)
- And said to them; You brought this man to me as one inciting the people to revolt, and, look! I examined him in front of you but found in this man no ground for the charges you are bringing against him. (Luke 23:14)
- And in your loving-kindness may you silence my enemies, and you must destroy all those showing hostility to my soul, for I am your servant. (Psalms 143:12)
- Look! My servant whom I chose, my beloved, whom my soul approved! I will put my spirit upon him, and what justice is he will make clear to the nations. (Matthew 12:18)
- And, after binding him, they led him off and handed him over to Pilate the governor. (Matthew 27:2)
- He said; Why, what bad thing did he do? Still they kept crying out all the more; Let him be impaled! (Matthew 27:23)
- And immediately at dawn the chief priests with the older men and the scribes, even the whole Sanhedrin, conducted a consultation, and they bound Jesus and led him off and handed him over to Pilate. (Mark 15:1)
- So Pilate put the question to him; Are you the king of the Jews? In answer to him he said; You yourself say it. (Mark 15:2)
- But Pilate went on to say to them; Why, what bad thing did he
 Still they cried out all the more; Impale him! (Mark 15:14)
- But he that disowns me before men will be disowned before the angels of God. (Luke 12:9)
- For instance, he will be delivered up to men of the nations and will be made fun of and be treated insolently and spit upon. (Luke 18:32)
- And how our chief priests and rulers handed him over to the sentence of death and impaled him. (Luke 24:20)
- Jesus answered; If I glorify myself, my glory is nothing. It is my Father that glorifies me, he who you say is your God. (John 8:54)

- Then they led Jesus from Caiaphas to the governor's palace. It was now early in the day. But they themselves did not enter into the governor's palace, that they might not get defiled but might eat the Passover. (John 18:28)
- However, when the chief priests and the officers saw him, they shouted, saying; Impale him! Impale him! Pilate said to them; Take him yourselves and impale him, for I do not find any fault in him. (John 19:6)
- Even so, both Herod and Pontius Pilate with men of nations and with peoples of Israel were in actuality gathered together in this city against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed. (Acts of Apostles 4:27)
- He said; The God of our forefathers has chosen you to come to know his will and to see the righteous One and to hear the voice of his mouth. (Acts of Apostles 22:14)
- But I do admit this to you, that, according to the way that they call a sect, in this manner I am rendering sacred service to the God of my forefathers, as I believe all the things set forth in the Law and written in the Prophets. (Acts of Apostles 24:14)
