Acts of Apostles 7:36... This man led them out after doing portents and signs in Egypt and in the Red Sea and in the wilderness for forty years.

- And it came about at the end of the four hundred and thirty **years**, it even came about on this very day that all the armies of Yehowah went **out** of the land of **Egypt**. (**Exodus 12:41**)
- As for me, I shall let Pharaoh's heart become obstinate, and I shall certainly multiply my **signs** and my miracles in the land of **Egypt**. (**Exodus 7:3**)
- Later on Yehowah said to Moses; Say to Aaron, Stretch your hand with your rod **out** over the rivers, the Nile canals and the reedy pools and make the frogs come up over the land of Egypt. (**Exodus 8:5**)
- So they took the soot of a kiln and stood before Pharaoh, and Moses tossed it toward the heavens, and it became boils with blisters, breaking **out** on man and beast. (**Exodus 9:10**)
- They set among them the matters of his **signs**, and the miracles in the land of Ham. (**Psalms 105:27**)
- Moses now stretched his hand **out** over the sea, and Yehowah began making the sea go back by a strong east wind all night long and converting the sea basin into dry ground, and the waters were being split apart. (**Exodus 14:21**)
- The surging waters proceeded to cover them, down they went into the depths like a stone. (**Exodus 15:5**)
- By faith they passed through the **Red Sea** as on dry land, but on venturing **out** upon it the Egyptians were swallowed up. (**Hebrews 11:29**)

- And the sons of Israel ate the manna **forty years**, until their coming to a land inhabited. The manna was what they ate until their coming to the frontier of the land of Canaan. (**Exodus 16:35**)
- And **YOUR** sons will become shepherds in the **wilderness forty years**, and they will have to answer for **YOUR** acts of fornication, until **YOUR** carcasses come to their end in the **wilderness**. (**Numbers 14:33**)
- And I shall have to stretch **out** my hand and strike **Egypt** with all my wonderful acts that I shall do in the midst of it, and **after** that he will send **you out**. (**Exodus 3:20**)
- And it must occur that, to quote him, if they will not believe you and will not listen to the voice of the first sign, then they will certainly believe the voice of the later sign. (**Exodus 4:8**)
- You, you will speak all that I shall command you, and Aaron your brother will do the speaking to Pharaoh, and he must send the sons of Israel away from his land. (**Exodus 7:2**)
- And Yehowah said further to Moses; Go, move up from here, you and the people whom you **led up out** of the land of **Egypt**, to the land about which I swore to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, saying; To your seed I shall give it. (**Exodus 33:1**)
- By the number of the days that **you** spied **out** the land, **forty** days, a day for a year, a day for a year, **you** will answer for **YOUR** errors **forty years**, as **you** must know what my being estranged means. (**Numbers 14:34**)
- So Yehowah's anger blazed against Israel and he made them wander about in the **wilderness forty years**, until all the generation that was **doing** evil in the eyes of Yehowah came to their end. (**Numbers 32:13**)
- And Moses was a hundred and twenty **years** old at his death. His eye had not grown dim, and his vital strength had not fled. (**Deuteronomy 34:7**)
- Then you gave **signs** and miracles against Pharaoh and all his servants and all the people of his land, for you knew that they acted presumptuously against them, and you proceeded to make a name for yourself as at this day. (**Nehemiah 9:10**)
- You have **led** your people just like a flock, by the hand of Moses and Aaron. (**Psalms 77:20**)

- He sent **signs** and miracles into the midst of you, O **Egypt**, upon Pharaoh and upon all his servants. (**Psalms 135:9**)
- For I brought you up **out** of the land of **Egypt**, and from the house of slaves I redeemed you, and I proceeded to send before you Moses, Aaron and Miriam. (**Micah 6:4**)
- Moreover, through the hands of the apostles many **signs** and **portents** continued to occur among the people, and they were all with one accord in Solomon's colonnade. (**Acts of Apostles 5:12**)
