

WITNESSES - STEPHEN - OBSTINATE MEN, UNCIRCUMCISED

~ **Witness** ... **Stephen** ... Obstinate men and uncircumcised in hearts and ears - you are always resisting the Holy Spirit as your forefathers did so you do. (**Acts of Apostles 7:51**) ^{[47] - References}

Acts of Apostles 7:51... **Obstinate men and uncircumcised in hearts and ears, YOU are always resisting the Holy Spirit, as YOUR forefathers did, so YOU do.**

- Yet I, for my part, proceeded to walk in opposition to them, and I had to bring them into the land of their enemies. Perhaps at that time their **uncircumcised** heart will be humbled, and at that time they will pay off their error. (**Leviticus 26:41**)
- And **YOU** must circumcise the foreskin of **YOUR hearts** and not harden **YOUR** necks any longer. (**Deuteronomy 10:16**)
- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They have left Yehowah, they have treated the Holy One of Israel with disrespect, they have turned backwards. (**Isaiah 1:4**)
- But they themselves rebelled and made his **Holy Spirit** feel hurt. He now was changed into an enemy of theirs, he himself warred against them. (**Isaiah 63:10**)
- To whom shall I speak and give warning, that they may hear? Look! Their ear is **uncircumcised**, so that they are unable to pay attention. Look! The very word of Yehowah has become to them a reproach, in which word they can take no delight. (**Jeremiah 6:10**)
- And Yehowah went on to say to Moses; I have looked at this people and here it is a stiff-necked people. (**Exodus 32:9**)
- To a land flowing with milk and honey, for I shall not go up in the midst of you, because you are a stiff-necked people, that I may not exterminate you on the way. (**Exodus 33:3**)

- In case **you** should turn back from following him, he also would certainly once again let them stay longer in the wilderness, and **you** would have acted ruinously toward all this people. (**Numbers 32:15**)
- So I spoke to **you**, and **you** did not listen but began to behave rebelliously against Yehowah's order and to get all heated up, and you tried to go up into the mountain. (**Deuteronomy 1:43**)
- And you must know that it is not for your righteousness that Yehowah your God is giving you this good land to take possession of it, for you are a stiff-necked people. (**Deuteronomy 9:6**)
- **You** have proved yourselves rebellious in behavior with Yehowah from the day of my knowing **you**. (**Deuteronomy 9:24**)
- As for the good-for-nothing **men**, they said; How will this one save us? Accordingly they despised him, and they did not bring any gift to him. But he continued like one grown speechless. (**1 Samuel 10:27**)
- And he continued to do what was bad in Yehowah's eyes, just as Manasseh his father had done. (**2 Kings 21:20**)
- And Yehowah kept speaking to Manasseh and his people, but they paid no attention. (**2 Chronicles 33:10**)
- From the days of our **forefathers** we have been in great guiltiness until this day, and because of our errors we have been given, we ourselves, our kings, our priests, into the hand of the kings of the lands with the sword, with the captivity and with the plunder and with shame of face, just as this day. (**Ezra 9:7**)
- However, Jonathan the son of Asahel and Jahzeiah the son of Tikvah themselves stood up against this, and Meshullam and Shabbethai the Levites were the ones that helped them. (**Ezra 10:15**)
- And they themselves, even our **forefathers**, acted presumptuously and proceeded to harden their neck, and they did not listen to your commandments. (**Nehemiah 9:16**)
- Do not exalt **your** horn on high. Do not speak with an arrogant neck. (**Psalms 75:5**)
- And they should not become like their **forefathers**, a generation stubborn and rebellious, a generation who had not prepared their heart and whose **spirit** was not trustworthy with God. (**Psalms 78:8**)

- And so I let them go in the stubbornness of their heart, they went walking in their own counsels. (**Psalms 81:12**)
- For the reason that they hated knowledge, and the fear of Yehowah they did not choose. (**Proverbs 1:29**)
- What is there yet to do for my vineyard that I have not already done in it? Why is it that I hoped for it to produce grapes, but it gradually produced wild grapes? (**Isaiah 5:4**)
- And he proceeded to say; Listen, please, O house of David. Is it such a little thing for **you** to tire out **men**, that **you** should also tire out my God? (**Isaiah 7:13**)
- Woe to the stubborn sons, is the utterance of Yehowah, those disposed to carry out counsel, but not that from me, and to pour out a libation, but not with my **spirit**, in order to add sin to sin. (**Isaiah 30:1**)
- For it is a rebellious people, untruthful sons, sons who have been unwilling to hear the Law of Yehowah. (**Isaiah 30:9**)
- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, the Holy One of Israel, has said; By coming back and resting **you** people will be saved. **YOUR** mightiness will prove to be simply in keeping undisturbed and in trustfulness. But **you** were not willing. (**Isaiah 30:15**)
- I have spread out my hands all day long to a stubborn people, those who are walking in the way that is not good, after their thoughts. (**Isaiah 65:2**)
- Get yourselves circumcised to Yehowah, and take away the foreskins of **YOUR hearts**, **you men** of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem, that my rage may not go forth just like a fire, and it certainly burn with no one to do the extinguishing, on account of the badness of **YOUR** dealings. (**Jeremiah 4:4**)
- But this very people has come to have a stubborn and rebellious heart, they have turned aside and keep walking in their course. (**Jeremiah 5:23**)
- Look! Days are coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will hold an accounting with everyone circumcised but still in uncircumcision. (**Jeremiah 9:25**)
- They have returned to the errors of their **forefathers**, the first ones, who refused to obey my words, but who themselves have walked after other gods in order to serve them. The house of Israel and the

house of Judah have broken my covenant that I concluded with their **forefathers**. (Jeremiah 11:10)

- This bad people who are refusing to obey my words, who are walking in the stubbornness of their heart and who keep walking after other gods in order to serve them and to bow down to them, will also become just like this belt that is fit for nothing. (Jeremiah 13:10)

- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Here I am bringing upon this city and upon all its cities all the calamity that I have spoken against it, because they have hardened their neck in order not to obey my words. (Jeremiah 19:15)

- And Yehowah sent to **you** all his servants the prophets, rising up early and sending them, but **you** did not listen, neither did **you** incline **your** ear to listen. (Jeremiah 25:4)

- For the sons of Israel and the sons of Judah have proved to be mere doers of what was bad in my eyes, from their youth on up, for the sons of Israel are even offending me by the work of their hands, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 32:30)

- And he went on to say to me; Son of man, I am sending you to the sons of Israel, to rebellious nations that have rebelled against me. They themselves and their **forefathers** have transgressed against me down to this selfsame day. (Ezekiel 2:3)

- And you, O son of man, do not be afraid of them, and of their words do not be afraid, because there are obstinate ones and things pricking you and it is among scorpions that you are dwelling. Of their words do not you be afraid, and at their faces do not you be struck with terror, for they are a rebellious house. (Ezekiel 2:6)

- Will you judge them? Will you judge them, O son of man? Cause them to know the detestable things of their **forefathers**. (Ezekiel 20:4)

- And I proceeded to say to their sons in the wilderness; In the regulations of your **forefathers** do not **you** walk, and their judgments do not **you** keep, and with their dungy idols do not **you** defile yourselves. (Ezekiel 20:18)

- Therefore say to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; In the way of **your forefathers** are **you** people defiling yourselves, and after their disgusting things are **you** going in immoral intercourse? (Ezekiel 20:30)

- And, on the other hand, I myself have become full of power, with the **spirit** of Yehowah, and of justice and mightiness, in order to tell to Jacob his revolt and to Israel his sin. (**Micah 3:8**)
- And their heart they set as an emery stone to keep from obeying the Law and the words that Yehowah of armies sent by his **spirit**, by means of the former prophets, so that there occurred great indignation on the part of Yehowah of armies. (**Zechariah 7:12**)
- From the days of **YOUR forefathers** **YOU** have turned aside from my regulations and have not kept them. Return to me, and I will return to **you**, Yehowah of armies has said. And **you** have said; In what way shall we return? (**Malachi 3:7**)
- On this account I say to **you**; Every sort of sin and blasphemy will be forgiven **men**, but the blasphemy against the **spirit** will not be forgiven. (**Matthew 12:31**)
- But he is a Jew who is one on the inside, and his circumcision is that of the heart by **spirit**, and not by a written code. The praise of that one comes, not from **men**, but from God. (**Romans 2:29**)
- For just as **you** were once disobedient to God but have now been shown mercy because of their disobedience. (**Romans 11:30**)
- And a reed like a rod was given me as he said; Get up and measure the temple sanctuary of God and the altar and those worshiping in it. (**Revelation 11:1**)
