Isaiah 43:10... You are my witnesses, is the utterance of Yehowah, even my servant whom I have chosen, in order, that you may know and have faith in me, and that you may understand that I am the same One. Before me there was no God formed, and after me there continued to be none.

- In order that people may know from the rising of the sun and from its setting that there is none besides me. I am Yehowah, and there is no one else. (Isaiah 45:6)
- And they must place my name upon the sons of Israel, that I myself may bless them. (Numbers 6:27)
