Proverbs 18:22· Has one found a good wife? One has found a good thing, and one gets goodwill from Yehowah.

- After that Isaac brought her into the tent of Sarah his mother. Thus he took Rebekah and she became his **wife**, and he fell in love with her, and Isaac **found** comfort after the loss of his mother. (**Genesis 24:67**)
- A capable **wife** is a crown to her owner, but as rottenness in his bones is she that acts shamefully. (**Proverbs 12:4**)
- A capable **wife** who can find? Her value is far more than that of corals. (**Proverbs 31:10**)
- See life with the **wife** whom you love all the days of your vain life that He **has** given you under the sun, all the days of your vanity, for that is your portion in life and in your hard work with which you are working hard under the sun. (**Ecclesiastes 9:9**)
- Yet, because of prevalence of fornication, let each man have his own **wife** and each woman have her own husband. (**1 Corinthians 7:2**)
- And Jacob proceeded to serve seven years for Rachel, but in his eyes they proved to be like some few days because of his love for her. (**Genesis 29:20**)
- The inheritance from fathers is a house and wealth, but a discreet **wife** is from **Yehowah**. (**Proverbs 19:14**)
- At this all the people that were in the gate and the older men said; Witnesses! May **Yehowah** grant the **wife** who is coming into your house to be like Rachel and like Leah, both of whom built the house of Israel, and you prove your worth in Ephrathah and make a notable name in Bethlehem. (**Ruth 4:11**)
