- But pay attention to yourselves that **YOUR** hearts never become weighed down with overeating and heavy drinking and anxieties of life, and suddenly that day be instantly upon **YOU**. (**Luke 21:34**)
- As a snare. For it will come in upon all those dwelling upon the face of all the earth. (**Luke 21:35**)
- As in the daytime let us walk decently, not in revelries and drunken bouts, not in illicit intercourse and loose conduct, not in strife and jealousy. (**Romans 13:13**)
- Envy, drunken bouts, revelries, and things like these. As to these things I am forewarning **YOU**, the same way as I did forewarn **YOU**,

that those who practice such things will not inherit God's kingdom.

- Wine is a ridiculer, **intoxicating liquor** is boisterous, and everyone going astray by it is not wise. (**Proverbs 20:1**)

- Those staying a long time with the **wine**, those coming in to search out mixed **wine**. (**Proverbs 23:30**)

- Fornication and **wine** and sweet **wine** are what take away good motive. (**Hosea 4:11**)

- Do not come to be among heavy drinkers of **wine**, among those who are gluttonous eaters of flesh. (**Proverbs 23:20**)

- Woe to those who are mighty in drinking **wine**, and to the men with vital energy for mixing **intoxicating liquor**. (**Isaiah 5:22**)

- On the day of our king, princes have sickened themselves, there is a rage because of **wine**. He has drawn his hand along with deriders. (**Hosea 7:5**)

- That are drinking out of bowls of **wine**, and that with the choicest oils do their anointing, and that have not been made sick at the catastrophe of Joseph. (**Amos 6:6**)

- But pay attention to yourselves that **YOUR** hearts never become weighed down with overeating and heavy drinking and anxieties of life, and suddenly that day be instantly upon **you**. (**Luke 21:34**)

- Also, do not be **getting** drunk with **wine**, in which there is debauchery, but keep **getting** filled with spirit. (**Ephesians 5:18**)
