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WOE - TO STUBBORN SONS

~ Men ··· Unrighteous ··· Woe To Stubborn Sons - Woe to stubborn sons, those who carry out counsel but not mine, those who pour out a libation, but not with my spirit, thus adding sin to sin · (Isaiah 30:1) [25] - References

Isaiah 30:1" Woe to the stubborn sons, is the utterance of Yehowah, those disposed to carry out counsel, but not that from me, and to pour out a libation, but not with my spirit, in order to add sin to sin.

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- Vengeance is mine, and retribution. At the appointed time their foot will move unsteadily, for the day of their disaster is near, and the events in readiness for them do make haste. (Deuteronomy 32:35)
- Woe to those who are going very deep in concealing counsel from Yehowah himself, and whose deeds have occurred in a dark place, while they say; Who is seeing us, and who is knowing of us? (Isaiah 29:15)
- But they themselves rebelled and made his Holy Spirit feel hurt. He now was changed into an enemy of theirs, he himself warred against them. (Isaiah 63:10)
- For this reason Pilate kept on seeking how to release him. But the Jews shouted, saying; If you release this man, you are not a friend of Caesar. Every man making himself a king speaks against Caesar. (John 19:12)
- Therefore Pilate, after hearing these words, brought Jesus outside, and he sat down on a judgment seat in a place called The Stone Pavement, but, in Hebrew, Gabbatha. (John 19:13)
- Now it was preparation of the Passover, it was about the sixth hour. And he said to the Jews; See! Your king! (John 19:14)
- However, they shouted; Take him away! Take him away! Impale him! Pilate said to them; Shall I impale YOUR king? The chief priests answered; We have no king but Caesar. (John 19:15)

- It is to you, therefore, that he is precious, because you are believers, but to those not believing, the identical stone that the builders rejected has become the head of the corner. (1 Peter 2:7)
- And a stone of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense. These are stumbling because they are disobedient to the word. To this very end they were also appointed. (1 Peter 2:8)
- However, there also came to be false prophets among the people, as there will also be false teachers among you. These very ones will quietly bring in destructive sects and will disown even the owner that bought them, bringing speedy destruction upon themselves. (2 Peter 2:1)
- For if we practice sin willfully after having received the accurate knowledge of the truth, there is no longer any sacrifice for sins left. (Hebrews 10:26)
- But there is a certain fearful expectation of judgment and there is a fiery jealousy that is going to consume those in opposition. (Hebrews 10:27)
- Any man that has disregarded the Law of Moses dies without compassion, upon the testimony of two or three. (Hebrews 10:28)
- Of how much more severe a punishment, do you think, will the man be counted worthy who has trampled upon the Son of God and who has esteemed as of ordinary value the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and who has outraged the spirit of undeserved kindness with contempt? (Hebrews 10:29)
- For we know him that said; Vengeance is mine, I will recompense, and again; Yehowah will judge his people. (Hebrews 10:30)
- It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. (Hebrews 10:31)
- Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth, for Yehowah himself has spoken; Sons I have brought up and raised, but they themselves have revolted against me. (Isaiah 1:2)
- I have spread out my hands all day long to a stubborn people, those who are walking in the way that is not good, after their thoughts. (Isaiah 65:2)

- Obstinate men and uncircumcised in hearts and ears, you are always resisting the Holy Spirit, as your forefathers did, so you do. (Acts of Apostles 7:51)
- And they will actually eat, but will not get satisfied. They will actually treat women as harlots, but they will not increase, because they have left off paying regard to Yehowah himself. (Hosea 4:10)
- So, then, the man that shows disregard is disregarding, not man, but God, who puts his Holy Spirit in You. (1 Thessalonians 4:8)
- And here you have risen in the place of YOUR fathers as the brood of sinful men in order to add further to the burning anger of Yehowah against Israel. (Numbers 32:14)
- The error of Ephraim is wrapped up, his sin is treasured up. (Hosea 13:12)
- And it must occur that when someone has heard the words of this oath, and he has blessed himself in his heart, saying; I shall come to have peace, although I shall walk in the stubbornness of my heart, with the intention of sweeping away the well-watered one along with the thirsty ones. (Deuteronomy 29:19)
- Consequently the king took counsel and made two golden calves and said to the people; It is too much for you to go up to Jerusalem. Here is your God, O Israel, that brought you up out of the land of Egypt. (1 Kings 12:28)
- However, he left the counsel of the older men with which they had advised him, and he began to take counsel with the young men that had grown up with him, who were the ones attending upon him. (2 Chronicles 10:8)
- He is wise in heart and strong in power. Who can show stubbornness to him and come off uninjured? (Job 9:4)
- Happy is the man that is feeling dread constantly, but he that is hardening his heart will fall into calamity. (Proverbs 28:14)
- All of them are the most stubborn men, walking about as slanderers, copper and iron. They are all of them ruinous. (Jeremiah 6:28)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; As for you men and your wives, you women also speak with your mouths, and with your hands you people have made a fulfillment, saying; We shall without fail perform our vows that we have vowed, to make

sacrificial smoke to the queen of the heavens' and to pour out drink offerings to her. You women will without fail carry out Your vows, and You will without fail perform Your vows. (Jeremiah 44:25)

- Then he said to me; Son of man, these are the men that are scheming hurtfulness and advising bad counsel against this city. (Ezekiel 11:2)
- In order that those of the house of Israel may no more go wandering off from following me and may no more go defiling themselves with all their transgressions. And they must become my people and I myself shall become their God, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 14:11)
- And a sword will certainly whirl about in his cities and make an end of his bars and devour because of their counsels. (Hosea 11:6)
- And the statutes of Omri and all the work of the house of Ahab are observed, and you people walk in their counsels, to the end that I may make you an object of astonishment and her inhabitants something to be whistled at, and the reproach of peoples you men will bear. (Micah 6:16)
