Isaiah 5:12· And there must prove to be harp and stringed instrument, tambourine and flute, and wine at their feasts, but the activity of Yehowah they do not look at, and the work of his hands they have not seen.

- Later Abigail came in to Nabal, and there he was having a feast in his house like the feast of the king, and Nabal's heart was feeling good within him, and he was as drunk as could be, and she did not tell him a thing, small or great, until the morning light. (**1 Samuel 25:36**)
- For the reason that they **have** turned aside from following him, and none of his ways **have** they considered. (**Job 34:27**)
- The heavens are declaring the glory of God, and of the **work** of his **hands** the expanse is telling. (**Psalms 19:1**)
- For they **have** no regard for the activities of **Yehowah**, nor for the **work** of his **hands**. He will tear them down and not build them up. (**Psalms 28:5**)
- No unreasoning man himself can know them, and no one stupid can understand this. (**Psalms 92:6**)
- It is after that that you will come to the hill of the true God, where there is a garrison of the Philistines. And it should come about that at the time of your coming there to the city, you will certainly meet a group of prophets coming down from the high place, and ahead of them a **stringed instrument** and **tambourine** and **flute** and **harp**, while they are speaking as prophets. (**1 Samuel 10:5**)
- After that all the people came on up following him, and the people were playing on **flutes** and rejoicing with great joy, so that the earth was split by the noise of them. (**1 Kings 1:40**)

- They continue raising their voice with the **tambourine** and **harp**, and keep rejoicing at the sound of the pipe. (**Job 21:12**)
- Praise him with the **tambourine** and the circle dance. Praise him with strings and the pipe. (**Psalms 150:4**)
- Better is it to go to the house of mourning than to go to the banquet house, because that is the end of all mankind, and the one alive should take it to his heart. (**Ecclesiastes 7:2**)
- But, **look!** Exultation and rejoicing, the killing of cattle and the slaughtering of sheep, the eating of flesh and the drinking of **wine**, Let there be eating and drinking, for tomorrow we shall die. (**Isaiah 22:13**)
- Though the wicked one should be shown favor, he simply will not learn righteousness. In the land of straightforwardness he will act unjustly and will not see the eminence of **Yehowah**. (**Isaiah 26:10**)
- That are improvising according to the sound of the **stringed instrument**, that, like David, **have** devised for themselves **instruments** for song. (**Amos 6:5**)
