WOE - TO TREACHEROUS DESPOILERS

- Men "Unrighteous "Woe To Treacherous, Despoilers- Woe to those despoiling but who have not been despoiled those dealing treacherously to whom others have not dealt treacherously, When you have finished your wicked works they will come back upon your own heads' (Isaiah 33:1) [20] References
- Isaiah 33:1. Woe to you who are despoiling, without you yourself being despoiled, and to you who are dealing treacherously, without others having dealt treacherously with you! As soon as you have finished as a despoiler, you will be despoiled. As soon as you have done with dealing treacherously, they will deal treacherously with you.

- Do not be misled! God is not one to be mocked. For whatever a man is sowing, this he will also reap. (Galatians 6:7)
- It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. (Hebrews 10:31)
- And in the fourteenth year of King Hezekiah, Sennacherib the king of Assyria came up against all the fortified cities of Judah and proceeded to seize them. (2 Kings 18:13)
- For Ahaz stripped the house of Yehowah and the house of the king and of the princes and thus made a gift to the king of Assyria, but it was of no assistance to him. (2 Chronicles 28:21)
- Aha, the Assyrian, the rod for my anger, and the stick that is in their hand for my denunciation! (Isaiah 10:5)
- And it must occur that when Yehowah terminates all his work in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem, I shall make an accounting for the fruitage of the insolence of the heart of the king of Assyria and for the self-importance of his loftiness of eyes. (Isaiah 10:12)
- And it must occur that everyone seeing you will flee away from you and will certainly say, Nineveh has been despoiled! Who will sympathize with her? From where shall I seek comforters for you? (Nahum 3:7)

- For with what judgment you are judging, you will be judged, and with the measure that you are measuring out, they will measure out to you. (Matthew 7:2)
- Then God let develop a bad spirit between Abimelech and the landowners of Shechem, and the landowners of Shechem proceeded to deal treacherously with Abimelech. (Judges 9:23)
- And it came about on the next day that he proceeded to take a coverlet and dip it in water and spread it out over his face, so that he died. And Hazael began to reign in place of him. (2 Kings 8:15)
- For Yehowah himself will plead their cause, and he will certainly rob of soul those robbing them. (Proverbs 22:23)
- The one striking peoples in fury with a stroke incessantly, the one subduing nations in sheer anger with a persecution without restraint. (Isaiah 14:6)
- May my dispersed ones reside as aliens even in you, O Moab. Become a place of concealment to them because of the despoiler. For the oppressor has reached his end, the despoiling has terminated, those trampling down others have been finished off the earth. (Isaiah 16:4)
- At evening time, why, look! There is sudden terror. Before morning, it is no more. This is the share of those pillaging us, and the lot belonging to those plundering us. (Isaiah 17:14)
- There is a hard vision that has been told to me; The treacherous dealer is dealing treacherously, and the despoiler is despoiling. Go up, O Elam! Lay siege, O Media! All sighing due to her I have caused to cease. (Isaiah 21:2)
- From the extremity of the land there are melodies that we have heard; Decoration to the Righteous One! But I say; For me there is leanness, for me there is leanness! Woe to me! The treacherous dealers have dealt treacherously. Even with treachery the treacherous dealers have dealt treacherously. (Isaiah 24:16)
- Howl, you shepherds, and cry out! And wallow about, you majestic ones of the flock, because your days for slaughtering and for your scatterings have been fulfilled, and you must fall like a desirable vessel! (Jeremiah 25:34)
- Therefore all those devouring you will themselves be devoured, and as for all your adversaries, into captivity they will all of them go.

And those pillaging you will certainly come to be for pillaging, and all those plundering you I shall give over to plundering. (Jeremiah 30:16)

- And they will actually shepherd the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in its entrances. And he will certainly bring about deliverance from the Assyrian, when he comes into our land and when he treads upon our territory. (Micah 5:6)
- Plunder silver, you men, plunder gold, as there is no limit to the things in arrangement. There is a heavy amount of all sorts of desirable articles. (Nahum 2:9)
- Because you yourself despoiled many nations, all the remaining ones of the peoples will despoil you, because of the shedding of blood of mankind and the violence to the earth, the town and all those dwelling in it. (Habakkuk 2:8)
