

WOMEN - CALL PEOPLE TO SACRIFICE

Numbers 25:2 And the women came calling the people to the sacrifices of their gods, and the people began to eat and to bow down to their gods.

- For fear that you may conclude a covenant with the inhabitants of the land, as they will certainly have immoral intercourse with their **gods** and sacrifice to their **gods**, and someone will be certain to invite you, and you will certainly **eat** some of his sacrifice. (**Exodus 34:15**)
- From the nations of whom Yehowah had said to the sons of Israel; **You** must not go in among them, and they themselves should not come in among **you**, truly they will incline **your** heart to follow their gods. It was to them that Solomon clung to love them. (**1 Kings 11:2**)
- To keep abstaining from things sacrificed to idols and from blood and from things strangled and from fornication. If **you** carefully keep yourselves from these things, **you** will prosper. Good health to **you**! (**Acts of Apostles 15:29**)
- No, but I say that the things which the nations sacrifice they sacrifice to demons, and not to God, and I do not want **you** to become sharers with the demons. (**1 Corinthians 10:20**)
- You must not **bow down** to them nor be induced to serve them, because I Yehowah your God am a God exacting exclusive devotion, bringing punishment for the error of fathers upon sons, upon the third generation and upon the fourth generation, in the case of those who hate me. (**Exodus 20:5**)
- By never going in among these nations, these that remain with **you**. And **you** must not mention the names of their **gods** nor swear by them, neither must **you** serve them nor **bow down** to them. (**Joshua 23:7**)
- Neither become idolaters, as some of them did, just as it is written; The **people** sat **down** to **eat** and drink, and they got up to have a good time. (**1 Corinthians 10:7**)

- You are not to conclude a covenant with them or their **gods**.
(Exodus 23:32)
- Then you will have to take some of their daughters for your sons, and their daughters will be certain to have immoral intercourse with their **gods** and make your sons have immoral intercourse with their **gods**. (Exodus 34:16)
- Take vengeance for the sons of Israel upon the Midianites. Afterward you will be gathered to your people. (Numbers 31:2)
- Look! They are the ones who, by Balaam's word, served to induce the sons of Israel to commit unfaithfulness toward Yehowah over the affair of Peor, so that the scourge **came** upon the assembly of Yehowah. (Numbers 31:16)
- Remember; Do not forget how you have provoked Yehowah your God in the wilderness. From the day that you went out of the land of Egypt until **YOUR** coming to this place **you people** have proved rebellious in **YOUR** behavior with Yehowah. (Deuteronomy 9:7)
- And **you** used to see their disgusting things and their dungy idols, wood and stone, silver and gold, that were with them. (Deuteronomy 29:17)
- Was the error of Peor too small for us, from which we have not cleansed ourselves **down** to this day, although the plague **came** to be upon the assembly of Yehowah? (Joshua 22:17)
- And they proceeded to take their daughters as wives for themselves, and their own daughters they gave to their sons, and they took up serving their **gods**. (Judges 3:6)
- And the sons of Israel again proceeded to do what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah, and they **began** to serve the Baals and the Ashtoreth images and the **gods** of Syria and the **gods** of Sidon and the **gods** of Moab and the **gods** of the sons of Ammon and the **gods** of the Philistines. So they left Yehowah and did not serve him. (Judges 10:6)
- Easily I have come to be in every sort of badness in the midst of the congregation and of the assembly. (Proverbs 5:14)
- On the mountains he did not **eat** and his eyes he did not raise to the dungy idols of the house of Israel, and his companion's wife he did not defile and to a woman in her impurity he would not go near. (Ezekiel 18:6)

- For the reason that they rejected my own judicial decisions, and as regards my statutes, they did not walk in them, and my Sabbaths they profaned, because it was after their dungy idols that their heart was going. ([Ezekiel 20:16](#))
- Nevertheless, I have a few things against you, that you have there those holding fast the teaching of Balaam, who went teaching Balak to put a stumbling block before the sons of Israel, to **eat** things sacrificed to idols and to commit fornication. ([Revelation 2:14](#))
