- John 1:18... No man has seen God at any time, the only-begotten god who is in the bosom position with the Father is the one that has explained him.

[27] - References

- And he added; You are not able to see my face, because no man may see me and yet live. (Exodus 33:20)
- Not that any man has seen the Father, except he who is from God, this one has seen the Father. (John 6:46)
- At no time has anyone beheld God. If we continue loving one another, God remains in us and his love is made perfect in us. (1 John 4:12)
- In the beginning the Word was, and the Word was with God, and the Word was a god. (John 1:1)
- Then I came to be beside him as a master worker, and I came to be the one he was specially fond of day by day, I being glad before him all the time. (Proverbs 8:30)
- There was reclining in front of Jesus' bosom one of his disciples, and Jesus loved him. (John 13:23)
- All things have been delivered to me by my Father, and no one fully knows the Son but the Father, neither does anyone fully know the Father but the Son and anyone to whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (Matthew 11:27)
