Jesus … Teaching … Work For Everlasting Life - Work not for ordinary food that perishes, but work for the food that remains for everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, for upon this one God the Father has placed his seal of approval (John 6:27) [19] - References

Work, not for the food that perishes, but for the food that remains for life everlasting, which the Son of man will give you, for upon this one the Father, even God, has put his seal of approval.

[19] - References

- Although the fig tree itself may not blossom, and there may be no yield on the vines, the work of the olive tree may actually turn out a failure, and the terraces themselves may actually produce no food, the flock may actually be severed from the pen, and there may be no herd in the enclosures. (Habakkuk 3:17)
- Whoever drinks from the water that I will give him will never get thirsty at all, but the water that I will give him will become in him a fountain of water bubbling up to impart everlasting life. (John 4:14)
- This means everlasting life, their taking in knowledge of you, the only true God, and of the one whom you sent forth, Jesus Christ. (John 17:3)
- For the wages sin pays is death, but the gift God gives is everlasting life by Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 6:23)
- He committed himself to Yehowah. Let Him provide him with escape! Let him deliver him, since he has taken delight in him! (Psalms 22:8)
