- For he who in this regard slaves for Christ is acceptable to **God** and has approval with men. **(Romans 14:18)**
- But, just as we have been proved by **God** as fit to be entrusted with the Good News, so we speak, as pleasing, not men, but **God**, who makes proof of our hearts. **(1 Thessalonians 2:4)**
- By giving these advices to the brothers you will be a fine minister of Christ Jesus, one nourished with the **words** of the faith and of the fine teaching which you have followed closely. **(1 Timothy 4:6)**
- Wholesome speech which cannot be condemned, so that the man on the opposing side may get **ashamed**, having **nothing** vile to say about us. **(Titus 2:8)**
- Preach the **word**, be at it urgently in favorable season, in troublesome season, reprove, reprimand, exhort, with all long-suffering and art of teaching. **(2 Timothy 4:2)**
- And I must set my face against that man and place him for a sign and for proverbial sayings, and I must cut him off from the midst of my people, and **you** people will have to know that I am Yehowah. **(Ezekiel 14:8)**
- Endurance, in turn, an **approved** condition, the **approved** condition, in turn, hope. **(Romans 5:4)**
- For not the one who recommends himself is **approved**, but the man whom Yehowah recommends. **(2 Corinthians 10:18)**

- To be sound in mind, chaste, workers at home, good, subjecting themselves to their own husbands, so that the **word** of **God** may not be spoken of abusively. (**Titus 2:5**)
- In all things showing yourself an example of fine works, showing uncorruptness in your teaching, seriousness. (**Titus 2:7**)
