~ Paul ··· Teaching ··· Workers Deserves Respect - Let anyone receiving oral teaching of the word share his good things with the one giving that teaching · (Galatians 6:6) [22] - References

Galatians 6:6. Moreover, let anyone who is being orally taught the word share in all good things with the one who gives such oral teaching.

[22] - References

- That you may know fully the certainty of the things that you have been taught orally. (Luke 1:4)
- This man had been orally instructed in the way of Yehowah and, as he was aglow with the spirit, he went speaking and teaching with correctness the things about Jesus, but being acquainted with only the baptism of John. (Acts of Apostles 18:25)
- Then Moses said to Aaron and his sons; Boil the flesh at the entrance of the tent of meeting, and there is where you will eat it and the bread that is in the installation basket, just as I was given the command, saying; Aaron and his sons will eat it. (Leviticus 8:31)
- So stay in that house, eating and drinking the things they provide, for the worker is worthy of his wages. Do not be transferring from house to house. (Luke 10:7)
- True, they have been pleased to do so, and yet they were debtors to them, for if the nations have shared in their spiritual things, they also owe it to minister publicly to these with things for the fleshly body. (Romans 15:27)
- If we have sown spiritual things to YOU, is it something great if we shall reap things for the flesh from YOU? (1 Corinthians 9:11)
- Moreover, do not forget the doing of good and the sharing of things with others, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased. (Hebrews 13:16)
- And you must eat it in every place, you and your household, because it is your wages in return for your service in the tent of meeting. (Numbers 18:31)

- Or a food pouch for the trip, or two undergarments, or sandals or a staff, for the worker deserves his food. (Matthew 10:10)
- In this way, too, the Lord ordained for those proclaiming the Good News to live by means of the Good News. (1 Corinthians 9:14)
- And to the sons of Levi, look! I have given every tenth part in Israel as an inheritance in return for their service that they are carrying on, the service of the tent of meeting. (Numbers 18:21)
- Then Moses gave the tax as Yehowah's contribution to Eleazar the priest, just as Yehowah had commanded Moses. (Numbers 31:41)
- At this Saul said to his attendant; And if we should go, what shall we bring to the man? because the bread itself has disappeared from our receptacles, and, as a gift, there is nothing to bring to the man of the true God. What is there with us? (1 Samuel 9:7)
- And there was a man that came from Baal-shalishah, and he came bringing to the man of the true God bread of the first ripe fruits, twenty barley loaves, and new grain in his bread bag. Then he said; Give it to the people that they may eat. (2 Kings 4:42)
- Do not hold back good from those to whom it is owing, when it happens to be in the power of your hand to do it. (Proverbs 3:27)
- Also, he gave them orders to carry nothing for the trip except a staff alone, no bread, no food pouch, no copper money in their girdle purses. (Mark 6:8)
- And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira and a worshiper of God, was listening, and Yehowah opened her heart wide to pay attention to the things being spoken by Paul. (Acts of Apostles 16:14)
- Now when she and her household got baptized, she said with entreaty; If you men have judged me to be faithful to Yehowah, enter into my house and stay. And she just made us come. (Acts of Apostles 16:15)
- Or a ministry, let us be at this ministry, or he that teaches, let him be at his teaching. (Romans 12:7)
- Because the ministry of this public service is not only to supply abundantly the wants of the holy ones but also to be rich with many expressions of thanks to God. (2 Corinthians 9:12)

- For the scripture says: You must not muzzle a bull when it threshes out the grain. Also: The workman is worthy of his wages. (1 Timothy 5:18)
- Carefully supply Zenas, who is versed in the Law, and Apollos for their trip, that they may not lack anything. (Titus 3:13)
