## **WORKERS - WAGES WITHHELD**

~ James ··· Teaching ··· Workers Wages - Look! The very wages that are due to the workers who have already worked in your fields, but which you keep holding back from them, keep crying out, and their voice reaches directly to Yehowah of armies · (James 5:4) [26] - References

James 5:4. Look! The wages due the workers who harvested Your fields but which are held up by You, keep crying out, and the calls for help on the part of the reapers have entered into the ears of Yehowah of armies.

[26] - References

- You must not defraud your fellow, and you must not rob. The wages of a hired laborer should not stay all night with you until morning. (Leviticus 19:13)
- Woe to the one building his house, but not with righteousness, and his upper chambers, but not with justice, by use of his fellowman who serves for nothing, and whose wages he does not give him. (Jeremiah 22:13)
- And I will come near to you people for the judgment, and I will become a speedy witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against those swearing falsely, and against those acting fraudulently with the wages of a wage worker, with the widow and with the fatherless boy, and those turning away the alien resident, while they have not feared me, Yehowah of armies has said. (Malachi 3:5)
- In his day you should give him his wages, and the sun should not set upon them, because he is in trouble and is lifting up his soul to his wages, that he may not cry out to Yehowah against you, and it must become sin on your part. (Deuteronomy 24:15)
- For, when looking for bloodshed, he will certainly remember those very ones, he is sure not to forget the outcry of the afflicted ones. (Psalms 9:12)

- Certainly, then, shall not God cause justice to be done for his chosen ones who cry out to him day and night, even though he is longsuffering toward them? (Luke 18:7)
- In my ears Yehowah of armies has sworn that many houses, though great and good, will become an outright object of astonishment, without an inhabitant. (Isaiah 5:9)
- If you should afflict him at all, then if he cries out to me at all, I shall unfailingly hear his outcry. (Exodus 22:23)
- Watch out for yourself for fear a base word should come to be in your heart, saying; The seventh year, the year of the release, has come close, and your eye should indeed become ungenerous toward your poor brother, and you should give him nothing, and he has to call out to Yehowah against you, and it has become a sin on your part. (Deuteronomy 15:9)
- They turn aside the poor ones from the way, at the same time the afflicted of the earth have kept themselves hidden. (Job 24:4)
- Between the terrace walls they pass the noontime, winepresses they have to tread, and yet they go thirsty. (Job 24:11)
- If its fruitage I have eaten without money, and the soul of its owners I have caused to pant. (Job 31:39)
- For the wicked has praised himself over the selfish longing of his soul, and the one making undue profit has blessed himself he has disrespected Yehowah. (Psalms 10:3)
- Yehowah is executing acts of righteousness and judicial decisions for all those being defrauded. (Psalms 103:6)
- Do not hold back good from those to whom it is owing, when it happens to be in the power of your hand to do it. (Proverbs 3:27)
- Entreaties the one of little means speaks out, but one that is rich answers in a strong way. (Proverbs 18:23)
- As for anyone stopping up his ear from the complaining cry of the lowly one, he himself also will call and not be answered. (Proverbs 21:13)
- There is a generation whose teeth are swords and whose jawbones are slaughtering knives, to eat up the afflicted ones off the earth and the poor ones from among mankind. (Proverbs 30:14)

- And I myself returned that I might see all the acts of oppression that are being done under the sun, and, look! The tears of those being oppressed, but they had no comforter, and on the side of their oppressors there was power, so that they had no comforter. (Ecclesiastes 4:1)
- If you see any oppression of the one of little means and the violent taking away of judgment and of righteousness in a jurisdictional district, do not be amazed over the affair, for one that is higher than the high one is watching, and there are those who are high above them. (Ecclesiastes 5:8)
- As the partridge that has gathered together what it has not laid is the one making riches, but not with justice. At the half of his days he will leave them, and in his finale he will prove to be senseless. (Jeremiah 17:11)
- There is a conspiracy of her prophets in the midst of her, like the roaring lion, tearing prey. A soul they actually devour. Treasure and precious things they keep taking. Her widows they have multiplied in the midst of her. (Ezekiel 22:25)
- Hear this word, You cows of Bashan, who are on the mountain of Samaria, who are defrauding the lowly ones, who are crushing the poor ones, who are saying to their masters; Do bring, and let us drink! (Amos 4:1)
- Get up, go to Nineveh the great city, and proclaim against her that their badness has come up before me. (Jonah 1:2)
- For out of the wall a stone itself will cry out plaintively, and from the woodwork a rafter itself will answer it. (Habakkuk 2:11)
- This is what they will have instead of their pride, because they reproached and kept putting on great airs against the people of Yehowah of armies. (Zephaniah 2:10)
