Galatians 5:19. Now the works of the flesh are manifest, and they are fornication, uncleanness, loose conduct.

[33] - References

- Even by his practices a boy makes himself recognized as to whether his activity is pure and upright. (Proverbs 20:11)
- For you are yet fleshly. For whereas there are jealousy and strife among you, are you not fleshly and are you not walking as men do? (1 Corinthians 3:3)
- In my letter I wrote you to quit mixing in company with fornicators. (1 Corinthians 5:9)
- Let fornication and uncleanness of every sort or greediness not even be mentioned among YOU, just as it befits holy people. (Ephesians 5:3)
- Deaden, therefore, YOUR body members that are upon the earth as respects fornication, uncleanness, sexual appetite, hurtful desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. (Colossians 3:5)
- Nevertheless, I do hold this against you, that you tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, and she teaches and misleads my slaves to commit fornication and to eat things sacrificed to idols. (Revelation 2:20)
- The nakedness of a woman and her daughter you must not lay bare. The daughter of her son and the daughter of her daughter you must not take in order to lay her nakedness bare. They are cases of blood relationship. It is loose conduct. (Leviticus 18:17)
- Adulteries, covetings, acts of wickedness, deceit, loose conduct, an envious eye, blasphemy, haughtiness, unreasonableness. (Mark 7:22)

- Having come to be past all moral sense, they gave themselves over to loose conduct to work uncleanness of every sort with greediness. (Ephesians 4:19)
- Furthermore, many will follow their acts of loose conduct, and on account of these the way of the truth will be spoken of abusively. (2 Peter 2:2)
- My reason is that certain men have slipped in who have long ago been appointed by the Scriptures to this judgment, ungodly men, turning the undeserved kindness of our God into an excuse for loose conduct and proving false to our only Owner and Lord, Jesus Christ. (Jude 1:4)
- But Er, Judah's firstborn, proved to be bad in the eyes of Yehowah, hence Yehowah put him to death. (Genesis 38:7)
- There is no one greater in this house than I am, and he has not withheld from me anything at all except you, because you are his wife. So how could I commit this great badness and actually sin against God? (Genesis 39:9)
- YOU people must not come near, any man of YOU, to any close fleshly relative of his to lay bare nakedness. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 18:6)
- And where a man takes a woman and her mother, it is loose conduct. They should burn him and them in the fire, in order, that loose conduct may not continue in YOUR midst. (Leviticus 20:14)
- In whose hands there is loose conduct, and whose right hand is full of bribery. (Psalms 26:10)
- Those in pursuit of loose conduct have come near, they have got far away from your own Law. (Psalms 119:150)
- The loose conduct of foolishness is sin, and a ridiculer is something detestable to mankind. (Proverbs 24:9)
- Your loose conduct and your detestable things, you yourself must bear them, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Ezekiel 16:58)
- By their fruits YOU will recognize them. Never do people gather grapes from thorns or figs from thistles, do they? (Matthew 7:16)
- For example, out of the heart come wicked reasonings, murders, adulteries, fornications, thieveries, false testimonies, blasphemies. (Matthew 15:19)

- For from inside, out of the heart of men, injurious reasonings issue forth, fornications, thieveries, murders. (Mark 7:21)
- For he that practices vile things hates the light and does not come to the light, in order, that his works may not be reproved. (John 3:20)
- Therefore God, in keeping with the desires of their hearts, gave them up to uncleanness, that their bodies might be dishonored among them. (Romans 1:24)
- And just as they did not approve of holding God in accurate knowledge, God gave them up to a disapproved mental state, to do the things not fitting. (Romans 1:28)
- What, then, was the fruit that you used to have at that time? Things of which you are now ashamed. For the end of those things is death. (Romans 6:21)
- For when we were in accord with the flesh, the sinful passions that were excited by the Law were at work in our members that we should bring forth fruit to death. (Romans 7:5)
- For those who are in accord with the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those in accord with the spirit on the things of the spirit. (Romans 8:5)
- So, then, brothers, we are under obligation, not to the flesh to live in accord with the flesh. (Romans 8:12)
- Perhaps, when I come again, my God might humiliate me among you, and I might mourn over many of those who formerly sinned but have not repented over their uncleanness and fornication and loose conduct that they have practiced. (2 Corinthians 12:21)
- For You know this, recognizing it for yourselves, that no fornicator or unclean person or greedy person, which means being an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of the Christ and of God. (Ephesians 5:5)
- The sins of some men are publicly manifest, leading directly to judgment, but as for other men their sins also become manifest later. (1 Timothy 5:24)
- Save them by snatching them out of the fire. But continue showing mercy to others, doing so with fear, while you hate even the inner garment that has been stained by the flesh. (Jude 1:23)
