Isaiah 65:11· But **you** men are those leaving Yehowah, those forgetting my holy mountain, those setting in order a table for the god of Good Luck and those filling up mixed wine for the god of Destiny.

^[14] - References

- You kept on looking until a stone was cut out not by hands, and it struck the image on its feet of iron and of molded clay and crushed them. (**Daniel 2:34**)
- At that time the iron, the molded clay, the copper, the silver and the gold were, all together, crushed and became like the chaff from the summer threshing floor, and the wind carried them away so that no trace at all was found of them. And as for the stone that struck the image, it became a large **mountain** and filled the whole earth. (**Daniel 2:35**)
- And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and was adorned with gold and precious stone and pearls and had in her hand a golden cup that was full of disgusting things and the unclean things of her fornication. (**Revelation 17:4**)
- And upon her forehead was written a name, a mystery. Babylon the Great, the mother of the harlots and of the disgusting things of the earth. (**Revelation 17:5**)
- And I saw that the woman was drunk with the blood of the **holy** ones and with the blood of the witnesses of Jesus. Well, on catching sight of her I wondered with great wonderment. (**Revelation 17:6**)
- For her sins have massed together clear up to heaven, and God has called her acts of injustice to mind. (**Revelation 18:5**)
- Render to her even as she herself rendered, and do to her twice as much, yes, twice the number of the things she did, in the cup in

which she put a mixture put twice as much of the mixture for her.
(**Revelation 18:6**)

- To the extent that she glorified herself and lived in shameless luxury, to that extent give her torment and mourning. For in her heart she keeps saying; I sit a queen, and I am no widow, and I shall never see mourning. (**Revelation 18:7**)

- That is why in one day her plagues will come, death and mourning and famine, and she will be completely burned with fire, because **Yehowah** God, who judged her, is strong. (**Revelation 18:8**)

- Then they will have to say; It was because they abandoned the covenant of **Yehowah** the God of their forefathers, which he concluded with them when he brought them out of the land of Egypt.
(**Deuteronomy 29:25**)

- They went sacrificing to demons, not to God, Gods whom they had not known, new ones who recently came in, with whom **YOUR** forefathers were not acquainted. (**Deuteronomy 32:17**)

- And you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father and serve him with a complete heart and with a delightful soul, for all hearts **Yehowah** is searching, and every inclination of the thoughts he is discerning. If you search for him, he will let himself be found by you, but if you leave him, he will cast you off forever. (**1 Chronicles 28:9**)

- Furthermore, Ahaz gathered together the utensils of the house of the true God and cut to pieces the utensils of the house of the true God, and closed the doors of the house of **Yehowah**, and made altars for himself at every corner in Jerusalem. (**2 Chronicles 28:24**)

- Due to the fact that they have left me and gone making sacrificial smoke to other **gods**, in **order** to offend me with all the doings of their hands and that my rage may pour forth upon this place and not be extinguished. (**2 Chronicles 34:25**)

- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They have left **Yehowah**, they have treated the Holy One of Israel with disrespect, they have turned backwards. (**Isaiah 1:4**)

- No, but I say that the things which the nations sacrifice they sacrifice to demons, and not to God, and I do not want **you** to become sharers with the demons. (**1 Corinthians 10:20**)

- You must not have any other **gods** against my face. (**Exodus 20:3**)
- Those staying a long time with the **wine**, those coming in to search out **mixed wine**. (**Proverbs 23:30**)
- For the reason that they have left me and have proceeded to make this place unrecognizable and to make sacrificial smoke in it to other **gods** whom they had not known, they and their forefathers and the kings of Judah, and they have filled this place with the blood of the innocent ones. (**Jeremiah 19:4**)
- And you sat down upon a glorious couch, with a **table** set in **order** before it, and my incense and my oil you put upon it. (**Ezekiel 23:41**)
