- Then he spoke to the assembly, saying; Turn aside, please, from before the tents of these wicked men and do not touch anything that belongs to them, that **you** may not be swept away in all their sin. **(Numbers 16:26)**

- Now I exhort **you**, **brothers**, to keep your eye on those who cause divisions and occasions for stumbling contrary to the teaching that **you** have learned, and avoid them. **(Romans 16:17)**

- Now we are giving **you** orders, **brothers**, in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, to withdraw from every **brother** walking disorderly and not according to the tradition **you** received from us. **(2 Thessalonians 3:6)**

- If **anyone** comes to **you** and does not bring this teaching, never receive him into **your** homes or say a greeting to him. **(2 John 1:10)**

- For **you** know this, recognizing it for yourselves, that no **fornicator** or unclean **person** or **greedy person**, which means being an **idolater**, has any inheritance in the kingdom of the Christ and of God. **(Ephesians 5:5)**

- And they must say to the older men of his city, This son of ours is stubborn and rebellious, he is not listening to our voice, being a glutton and a drunkard. **(Deuteronomy 21:20)**

- Nor thieves, nor **greedy persons**, nor **drunkards**, nor **revilers**, nor **extortioners** will inherit God's kingdom. **(1 Corinthians 6:10)**

- Envy, drunken bouts, revelries, and things like these. As to these things I am forewarning **you**, the same way as I did forewarn **you**, that those who practice **such** things will not inherit God's kingdom. (**Galatians 5:21**)
- For the time that has passed by is sufficient for **you** to have worked out the will of the nations when **you** proceeded in deeds of loose conduct, lusts, excesses with wine, revelries, drinking matches, and illegal idolatries. (**1 Peter 4:3**)
- For that is the way he commanded me by the word of Yehowah, saying; You must not eat bread or drink water, and you must not return by the way that you went. (**1 Kings 13:9**)
- Anyone slandering his companion in secrecy, him I silence. Anyone of haughty eyes and of arrogant heart, him I cannot endure. (**Psalms 101:5**)
- There will dwell inside my house no worker of trickiness. As for **anyone** speaking falsehoods, he will not be firmly established in front of my eyes. (**Psalms 101:7**)
- If he does not listen to them, speak to the congregation. If he does not listen **even** to the congregation, let him be to you just as a **man** of the nations and as a tax collector. (**Matthew 18:17**)
- Do not become unevenly yoked with unbelievers. For what fellowship do righteousness and Lawlessness have? Or what sharing does light have with darkness? (**2 Corinthians 6:14**)
- Let fornication and uncleanness of every sort or greediness not **even** be mentioned among **you**, just as it befits holy people. (**Ephesians 5:3**)
- But if **anyone** is not obedient to our word through this letter, keep this one marked, stop associating with him, that he may become ashamed. (**2 Thessalonians 3:14**)
- Nevertheless, I do hold this against you, that you tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, and she teaches and misleads my slaves to commit fornication and to eat things sacrificed to idols. (**Revelation 2:20**)
